In order to prevent harm or damage to users and their surroundings, this manual contains instructions that you are expected to follow. For safe use of the product, please fully understand the relevant content.



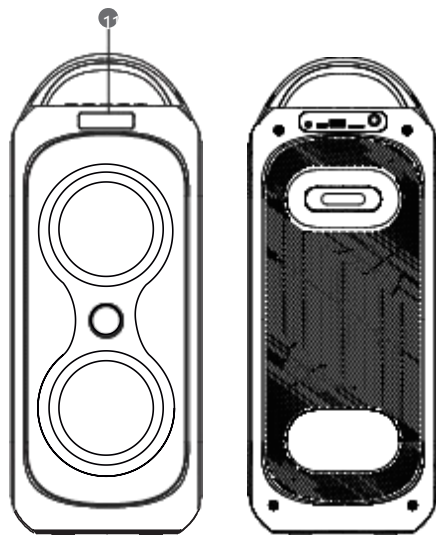
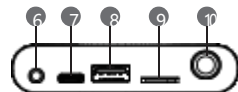
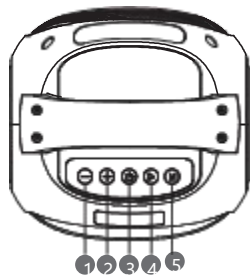
Attention

- Please do not use in unstable places or conditions.

- Avoid placing the device in a place facing the sun or sunlight for a long time.
- It cannot be disassembled or modified.

How to use your speaker

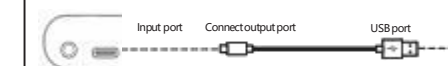


- Bluetooth mode: Short press to decrease volume/long press to move to previous track
- Radio mode: Short press to decrease volume, long press to switch to previous radio station
- Bluetooth mode: Short press volume up/long press for next track
- Radio mode: Short press to Volume Up/long press to switch to the next radio station
- Long press to turn on/off, short press to switch color lighting effects
- Bluetooth Mode: Short press to pause/play
- When a device (phone) is connected: Press and hold to disconnect it
- No device connection duration: Press to open TWS
- TWS connection duration: Press to disconnect TWS connection
- Radio mode: Short press to automatically search for radio stations
- Short press to switch modes BT/FM/TF/USB/AUX (the corresponding mode will be displayed on the screen)
- Long press to turn off and turn on the flashlight
- AUX port external 3.5mm audio signal cable
- Type-C charging port
- USB charging output/USB disk playback
- TF card slot
- Microphone interface
- 1. Display Screen

How to Charge Your Speaker

1. Use a 5V charging adapter
2. Insert the included Type-C charging cable into the input port of the device and connect the other end of the charger to the charging port. During the charging process, the charging indicator light on the charging port will turn red. After charging is completed, the charging indicator light will turn off.

3. After fully charged, unplug the charging cable.



- Do not use non-included chargers for charging
- When using this device for the first time, please fully charge it.
- When using a USB hub for charging, it may not charge properly. Please make sure to use the provided charger for charging, and do not use inferior chargers to charge the device. Charge in an environment with stable power supply.

It takes 4 hours to fully charge when the battery is depleted. When the charging light shows off, please unplug the charging cable.

Try not to use this device while charging. This will accelerate battery degradation and lead to battery damage.

Volume adjustment method

- Short press to decrease the volume.
- Short press to increase the volume. The volume can be adjusted between U-00 and U-30. In the case of U-00, it is silent.
- The volume can be adjusted in any mode.

How to use Bluetooth speaker

- Long press to power on, press "M" key to switch to "BT" mode.
- When the display screen "BLUE" is flashing, turn on your phone's Bluetooth, find "DF-720A", click and connect. When the device is in a connected state, "BLUE" will not flash.

Pause/Play

Short press to pause or play

Switch to the previous track

Long press "-" to play the previous song

Switch to the next track

Long press "+" to play the next song

Long press the button to disconnect the device from other devices via Bluetooth and put it in a waiting state. At this time, "BLUE" will continuously flash

TWS usage method

When two machines are not connected to any device, long press the key on either machine to open the TWS pair (a prompt sound will be heard when opening TWS, and a prompt sound will also be heard after successful connection). (When TWS needs to be connected, both devices switch to Bluetooth mode, and either one opens TWS pairing to wait for the other Bluetooth connection. Note that this operation requires disconnecting any Bluetooth device)

TF card usage method

- Switch to Bluetooth mode when turned on, insert the TF card into the TF port, and the device will automatically switch to "TF" mode and start playing audio files
 - Attention
- Supports up to 32GB TF card and supports MP3/WAV audio file formats

Pause/Play

Short press to pause or play

Switch to the previous track

Long press "-" to play the previous song

Switch to the next track

Long press "+" to play the next song

How to use AUX Input

Press the "M" key to switch to AUX mode
Connect the external device to the device using a 3.5mm audio signal cable to play audio.
Press the key to mute playback (note: using this function in AUX mode will mute, not pause playback)

Usage of USB flash drive

- Switch to Bluetooth mode when turned on, insert the USB flash drive into the USB port, and the device will automatically switch to "USB flash drive" mode and start playing audio files

Pause/Play

Short press to pause or play

Switch to the previous track

Long press "-" to play the previous song

Switch to the next track

Long press "+" to play the next song

How to use radio FM

Automatic channel search method

Short press the "M" key to switch FM radio mode
Long press the key to automatically start frequency search from low values, select and save the available channels.
When the first receivable channel is retrieved, the numerical value will stop once and display "P001"
When the second channel is retrieved, the numerical value stops again and displays "P002".
It automatically continues to receive until all channels are reached.

Long press the key to switch to the previous radio station with a signal.
Long press the key to switch to the next radio station with a signal.

* The number of channels that can be received may vary depending on the radio wave conditions in the usage location

Reminder

- When this product is damp, please wipe the moisture with a soft cloth
- When this product is contaminated, please put a small amount of neutral detergent in water and wipe it off with a soft cloth.
- After wiping with water, please air dry it in the shade.
- Please do not use diluents, gasoline, or alcohol to wipe the speaker.

Long term disuse

- Please charge once every 2-3 months.
- * Due to the characteristics of batteries, an empty battery may significantly shorten its lifespan and may not be able to charge.
- Please cut off the power supply for safekeeping.
- * Charging the battery for too long may significantly shorten its lifespan.
- Please do not store in a humid environment.
- * The metal parts may rust.
