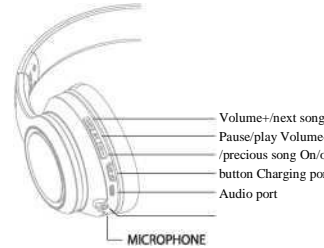

FUNCTION	OPERATION
● POWER ON	TOGGLE THE SWITCH BUTTON TO*ON*
(S) POWER OFF	TOGGLE THE SWITCH BUTTON TO *OFF*
● PAIRING	TOGGLE THE SWITCH BUTTON, THE RED AND BLUE LIGHTS FLASH AITERNATEIY FOR 3 SECONDS
● VOLUME +	SHORT PRESS-VOLUME +", LONG PRESS" NEXT SONG", WHEN ADDED TO THE LOUDEST, THERE WILL BE A "NOTICE VOICE"
● VOLUME-	SHORT PRESS -VOLUMES LONG PRESS - PREVIOUS SONG"
● PLAWPAUSE	PRESS PP BUTTON TO PLAY OR PAUSE
ANSWER CALL HANG UP CALL	INCOMING CALL, PRESS PP BUTTON TO ANSWER, PRESS PP BUTTON TO HANG UP

Precautions

A

- Do not use corrosive cleaners to clean the headset;

Pairing

- Toggle the switch button, the red and blue lights flash alternately.
- Open your bluetooth settings on your device and ensure it is switched on. Search for EGNARO HS7
- Select EGNARO HS7to pair.
- Once powered on again, the headset will automatically connect with mobile device.
