LAUNCH THE APP




To launch the selected app tap the cube twice

CONTROL GAMES




by twisting, tilting, and tapping the cube

GO BACK TO THE MAIN MENU




Shake the cube 3 times up and down

IF YOU WANT TO RESET THE CUBE




Place the cube on the charge and push the Reset button on the underside of the charge.






