


Take the earbuds out of the charging case, the power will automatically turn on and the earbuds prompt "Power ON".

When charging the earbuds, the pilot lamps of earbuds turn to red and they will turn off after the charging is finished

When charging the charging case, the pilot lamp o charging case flashes in red and it will stay in red after the charging is finished.

The Operations of Earbuds

POWER ON: 1. Take out the earbuds from charging case, they will automatically turn on;

2.Long press each of the touch sensor of earbuds for about 3 seconds

POWER OFF: 1. Put the earbuds into the charging case directly, the power will turn off;

2.Long press either of the touch sensors for about 3 seconds:

3. Leave the earbuds in paring mod(unparied) for about 3 minutes;

Play/Pause/Answer/Hang up: Press either of the touch sensors once.

Reject the phone call/Voice assistant: Long press either of the touch sensors for about 3 seconds;

Next song/Previous song: Double-press/Triple-press either of the touch sensors.
