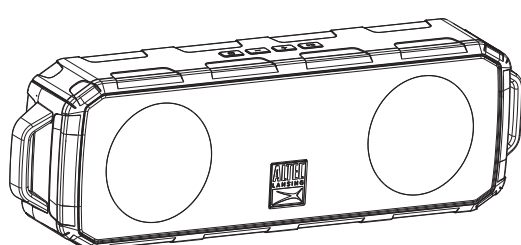

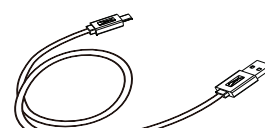

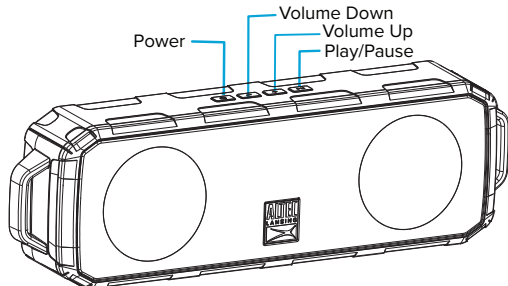


USB-C Charging Cable

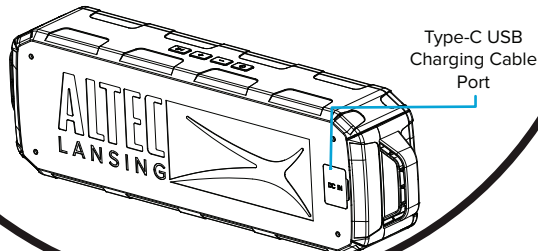

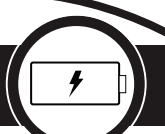

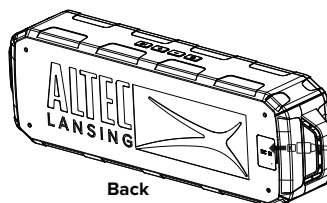

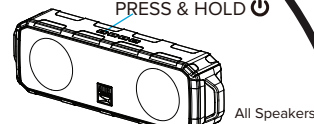

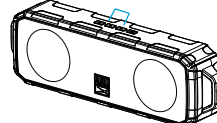
