# Read this first


Before operating the unit, please read this manual thoroughly, and retain it for future reference.

## WARNING

To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock,

- 1)do not expose the unit to rain or moisture.
- 2)do not place objects filled with liquids, such as vases, on the apparatus.

Do not expose the batteries to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.

 Do not ingest battery, chemical burn hazard.

The remote control contains a coin/button cell battery. If the coin/button cell battery is swallowed, it can cause severe internal burns in just 2 hours and can lead to death. Keep new and used batteries away from children. If the battery compartment does not close securely, stop using the product and keep it away from children.

If you think batteries might have been swallowed or placed inside any part of body, seek immediate medical attention.

## CAUTION

### Battery Pack

If the battery is mishandled, the battery pack can burst, cause a fire or even chemical burns. Observe the following cautions.

- Do not disassemble.

- Do not crush and do not expose the battery pack to any shock or force such as hammering, dropping or stepping on it.
- Do not short circuit and do not allow metal objects to come onto contact with the battery terminals.
- Do not expose to high temperature above 60°C (140°F) such as in direct sunlight or in a car parked in the sun.
- Do not incinerate or dispose of in fire.
- Do not handle damaged or leaking lithium ion batteries.
- Keep the battery pack out of the reach of small children.
- Keep the battery pack dry.
- Replace the battery with the specified type only. Otherwise, burst, fire or injury may result.
- Dispose of used batteries according to the instruction.

Use a nearby wall outlet(wall socket) when using the AC Adaptor/Battery Charger. If any malfunction occurs, disconnect the plug from the wall outlet (wall socket) immediately to disconnect from the power source. If you use the product with a charge lamp, note that the product is not disconnected from the power source even when the lamp turns off.

Do not use the AC Adaptor/Battery Charger placed in a narrow space, such as between a wall and furniture.

## NOTICE

If static electricity or electromagnetism cause data transfer to discontinue midway (fail), restart the application or disconnect and connect the communication cable (USB, etc.) again.

# About the camera

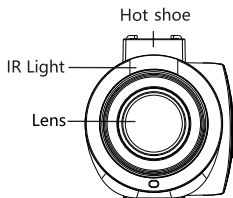
## System Requirement

Users can transfer videos and photos to computers with the following configurations:

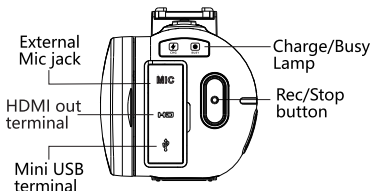

# About the camera

## Remote Control

Users can control the camcorder by remote control. Except as instruction of power on, the remote control can accomplish all other instructions.

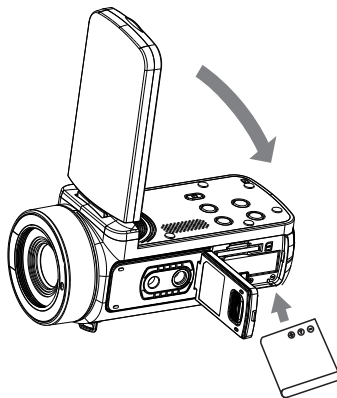


## Notes

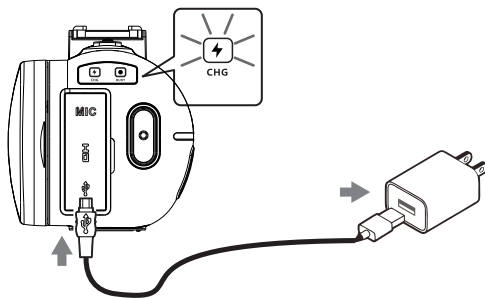
The remote control can not be used at a distance that is over 10 meters.

# Charging the battery

- 1 Turn off your camcorder by closing the IPS monitor, open the battery cover and insert the battery in the direction shown in the picture and close the battery cover.



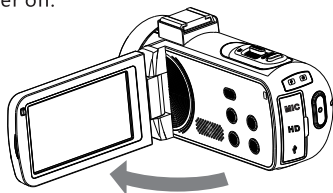
- 2 Connect the adaptor and the power cord (mains lead) to your camcorder and the wall outlet (wall socket)





- The CHG lamp turns red when the battery is charging.
- The CHG lamp turns off when the battery is fully charged.

# Turn the power on

Open the IPS monitor of your camcorder and the camcorder will turn the power on.



- You can also turn on the power by pressing the  **POWER** button.
- To turn off the camcorder, you can press the  **POWER** button for 3 seconds or close the IPS monitor.

## Notes

- It takes 5 seconds to turn on/off the camcorder by opening the IPS monitor. If you open/close the monitor twice in this reaction time, it may cause the camcorder can not turn on/off normally. Please wait for the machine to complete the power on / off procedure before operating the machine again.

# Setting the language

## Language

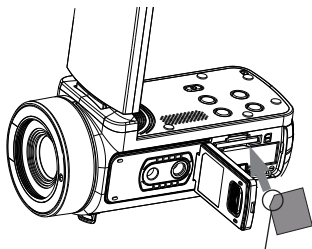
Press the **MENU** button to open the menu, press the **▲/▼/OK** button to choose Language and confirm.

- Setup→Language→Desired language.



# Inserting a memory card

- 1 Open the battery cover, and insert the memory card until it clicks.



Inserting the card with the noted corner in the direction as illustrated.

- 2 To eject the memory card, open the cover and lightly push the memory card in once.

## ■ To format the memory card

- To ensure stable operation of the memory card, it is recommended to format the memory card with your camcorder before the first use.
- Press the **MENU** button and press the **▲/▼/OK** button to select and confirm.
- **SETUP**→**Format**→**OK**



If the memory card is not native format, the camcorder will come out the pop-up prompt: Card error. Please format. Please format the memory as above operation.

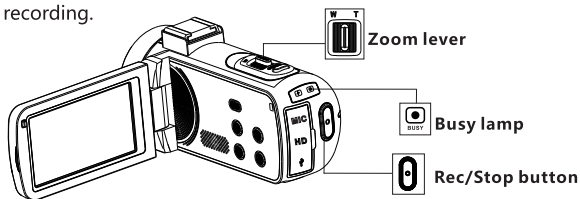
Formatting the memory card will erase all the data stored on it and the data will be irrecoverable. Save your important data on your PC, etc.



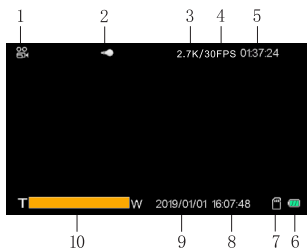
# Recording

Your camcorder records movies on a memory card. The factory setting of recording movie is 2.7K 30fps. Perform the following steps to record movies.

- 1 Open the IPS monitor, and press the **REC/Stop** button to start recording.

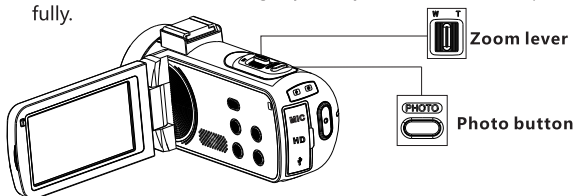
## Notes

If the movie file size exceeds 4GB while recording, the camcorder automatically divides the file and creates a new one.

(This is a fundamental limit of all FAT file systems. The maximum allowed file size on a FAT volume is 4GB. This restriction ensures that the video can be played on the computer.).

# Shooting photos

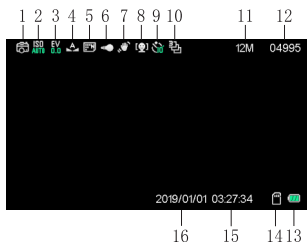
- 1 Open the IPS monitor, press the **MODE** button → Photo mode. Press the **PHOTO** button lightly to adjust the focus, then press it fully.



•The camcorder can not shoot in video mode.

- 2 You can manually adjust the zoom by turning the zoom lever.

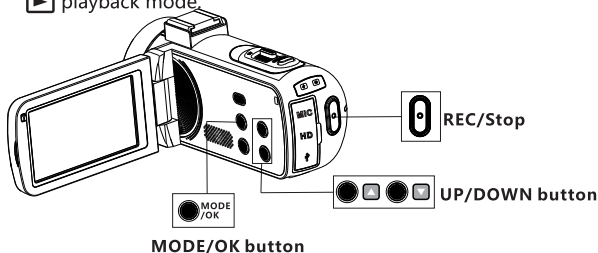

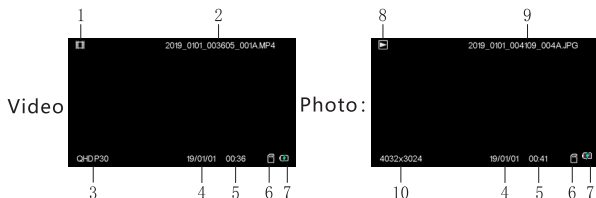
- 1 Open the IPS monitor and press the **MODE** button to enter the  playback mode.

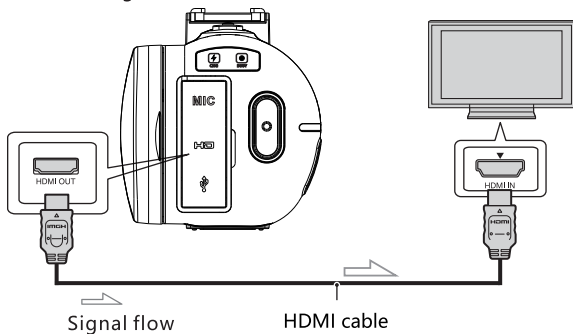

# Viewing the images on a TV

## Playing back images

Playable images may be restricted depending on the combination of the recording format, the type of playback images being selected, and the HDMI output settings.

- 1 Connect the HDMI OUT of the camcorder to the HDMI IN jack of a TV using the HDMI cable.



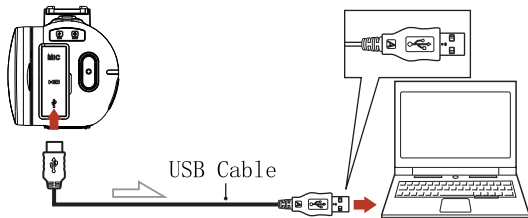
- 2 Set the input of TV to HDMI IN.
- 3 Play back images on the camcorder.

Press UP button to display icons.

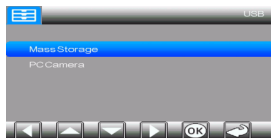
# Connect to computer

## How to connect

- 1 Connect the Mini USB port of this machine and the USB port of the computer with a UBS cable.



- 2 Turn over the display screen, the machine will automatically start up, the screen will show the following information:



Click to select Mass Storage or PC Camera, click to confirm.

### Transfer files:

Select MSDC, the computer will display the memory card disk of the camera, and the computer can transfer the files in the memory card.

### PC camera:

Select PC Camera, and the real-time images captured by the camera will be displayed on the computer. Please open the computer's camera program and select USB Camera.

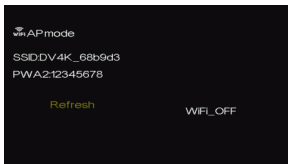
### Notes

- The operation methods and display screens for the application are subject to change without notice by future upgrades.

# Using the Wi-Fi function

## Connect to a Wi-Fi network

- 1 Turn over the display screen, the camcorder will automatically start up. → Press  MENU for 3 seconds and the screen will show the following information:



- 2 On smartphone, select [Settings] → select [WLAN] → Select the SSID of the camcorder and enter password displayed on camcorder to connect.
- 3 Go back to home and start up DV-CAM.

## Notes

- Depending on local electrical interference or the smartphone's capabilities, the live view images may not be displayed smoothly.


## Transferring Mp4 movies and photos to your smartphone

On a smartphone, play back an image to be downloaded to the smartphone.

- Open DV-CAM app, select [Device videos] - [VIDEO] or [PICTURE], then, select images you want to transfer, and select  to download it.
- Download files location: DV-CAM>Images/Videos.

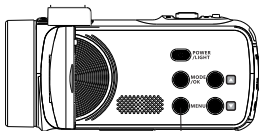
## Sharing images

  - Select , then, choose an APP to open and share with others.

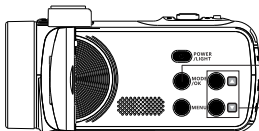

# Precautions

## AC Adaptor

Do not short-circuit the battery terminal with any metallic objects. This may cause a malfunction.

## Playing back images with other devices.

You may not be able to play back images that were recorded on your camcorder with other devices normally. Also, you may not be able to play images recorded on other devices with your camcorder.

## Recording and playback

- Avoid rough handling, disassembling, modifying, physical shock, or impact such as hammering, dropping or stepping on the product. Be particularly careful with the lens.
- To ensure stable operation of the memory card, it is recommended to format the memory card will erase all the data stored on it and the data will be irrecoverable. Save your important data on your PC, etc.
- Confirm the direction of the memory card. If you forcibly insert the memory card in the wrong direction, the memory card, memory card slot, or image data may be damaged.
- Before starting to record, test the recording function to make

- sure the image and sound are recorded without any problem. The camcorder is not dustproofed, dripproofed or waterproofed.
- Do not let your camcorder get wet, for example, from rain or sea water. If your camcorder gets wet, it may malfunction.
- Sometimes this malfunction cannot be repaired.
- Do not aim the camcorder at the sun or strong light. Doing so may cause your camcorder to malfunction.
- Do not use the camcorder on a sandy beach or anywhere dusty. Doing so may cause your camcorder to malfunction.
- If moisture condensation occurs, stop using the camcorder until moisture evaporates.
- Do not subject the camcorder to mechanical shock or vibration. If you do so, the camcorder may operate incorrectly or may not record
- images. In addition, the recording medium or recorded data may be damaged.

Other

## LCD monitor

The LCD monitor is manufactured using extremely high-precision technology, so over 99.99% of the pixels are operational for effective use. However, there may be some tiny black points and/or bright points(white, red, blue, or green in color) that appear constantly on the LCD monitor. These points are normal result of the manufacturing process and do not affect the recording in any way.

**IPS panel display**

the IPS panel may experience issues such as screen burn-in or loss of brightness with normal use over time. This not a malfunction.

**Camcorder temperature**

The camcorder and battery pack become warm during operation, This is normal.

## 4.2 Common problems and solutions

Problems	Possible Causes	Solutions
