

Moon light BT speaker

English version of the operating instructions

Power on: touch your finger to the charging port on the bottom of the BT speaker for 3 seconds

Power off: touch your finger to the charging port on the bottom of the BT speaker for 3 seconds

Connecting to BT: turn on the phone's BT to connect after turning on the speaker

The night light color: touch the charging port to change the color of the night light.

Automatically switch colors

after 8 colors

Remote control operation:

After the BT speaker is turned on, you can use the remote control to change the color of the night light

You need to remove the bottom transparent baffle for the first use

Remote control can be used to turn off the night light (press the LED button)

Play/pause, adjust the volume,
play the previous/next song
