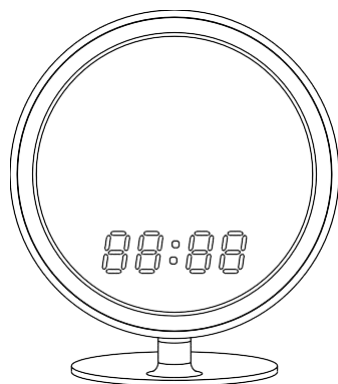

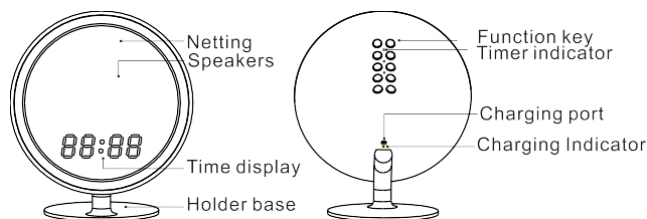

Product Features

1. Music playback function: Built-in 39 types of sleep-soothing music, including white noise, ocean waves, birdsong, running water, thunder, wind, and more. Covers most people's sound preferences.
2. Bluetooth function: both can play the built-in sound source of the machine, the user can also connect Bluetooth to play songs.
3. Time function: lightly press the "T" key to display the time.
4. Timing function: Timing can be selected: 30, 60, 90 minutes.
5. Durable battery life: built-in 1500mAh lithium battery, standard Type-C charging port.
6. Memory function: After power off, it can save the previous setting function, and after power on, it can restore the brightness of the night light before the last power off. The night light brightness, volume setting, and white noise playing automatically before the last power off

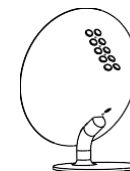

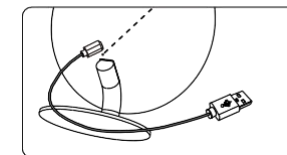
Instructions for use

Battery

Use the Type-C charger to charge the speaker, when charging, the speaker indicator light is red. When charging is complete, the speaker's indicator light will turn green.

Connect Bluetooth to play music

1. Long press the "Music/Bluetooth button" for 3 seconds to open Bluetooth, long press again for 3 seconds to enter pairing mode, after pairing successfully you can use Bluetooth to play music.
2. Open the Bluetooth of your cell phone, search and connect the Bluetooth device that starts with "MC330-***". speaker.

* Bluetooth Music Priority, when local music is playing, the phone plays music and the speaker automatically switches to Bluetooth music mode

Setting the clock

1. Press and hold down the "M" key, the time display "hour" flashes, press the "S" key to set the time.

Press the "M" key again, the time display "minute" blinks, press the "S" key to set the time and then press the "M" key.
After setting the time, press the "M" key.
*Connect the bluetooth speaker to synchronize the time of cell phone automatically.

Timer button setting instructions

Turn on your device or light in continuous play, until the timer is turned on. Press Timer button to set timer for 30/60/90 min. corresponding indicator for different timers setting will light up. Note: If no indicator lights up, device is in continuous working. Default mode is continuous working.

Function Introduction

ON/OFF

- Short press: Play/pause music
Long press: Turn ON/OFF

White noise level

- Short press: Play next song

Music/Bluetooth

- Short press: Play the next song
Long press: Connect/pair Bluetooth

Natural sounds

- Short press: Play next song

Time setting

- Long press: enter setting time mode
Short press: Setting is complete

Attention

1. Please place the device at least about 1 meter away from you or your baby so that it can fill your space properly and is good for your hearing.

Time display

- Short press: display time

Timer

- 30/60/90 min
Short press: Set timer

Volume up

- Increase music volume

Volume down

- Reduce music volume

Time adjustment

- Short press: increase time

Troubleshooting

If an abnormality is found during use, please refer to the following table to solve the problem.

The machine does not work / does not respond even when the button is pressed.

Reason: The power is not on because you didn't long press the power button.

Countermeasure: Don't short press, long press for about 3 seconds to turn the power on or off

The machine is powered on but does not make a sound

Cause: Volume set to minimum

Countermeasure: Press the Volume Up button before the volume is appropriate.

Charging indicator does not light up green even when charging for a long period of time

Cause: Charging with a USB cable / incompatible with the charger you are using.

Countermeasure: Please use another 5V / 1A USB power adapter or your computer's own USB port, etc. for charging.
