

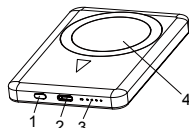

LED Indicators

- Press the Power bank ON/OFF Button(1) once to view the remaining power capacity.
- Double press the button to turn OFF the Power bank.
- WHITE indicators show capacity,each white light represents 25% of total capacity.
- BLUE indicator shows wireless charging function.LED will glow BLUE when in standby mode, and will flash BLUE when do wireless charging.
- GREEN indicator shows fast charging function. LED will glow GREEN when do fast charging.

Instructions:

1.Charging the Power bank:

- Charge the power bank fully before usage.
- Connect the cable input charging cable into a certified AC adapter or USB port of a computer, then charging begins automatically,white indicators will show power capacity. Users could also use their own USB / Type C charging cable to charge the power bank.
- Once connected the LED indicator(3) will begin to flash WHITE color when charging,once fully charged, WHITE LED will stay on.

2. Charging Electronic Devices with the Power Bank:

- Connect the charging cable to your mobile phone/device using the appropriate connector.
- Connect the Type-C part of the cable to the Type-C port(2) to contact your device, the LED Indicator will illuminate WHITE when charging.
- Remove the cable from your mobile device when it is fully charged.

3. Charging phone with the Wireless Charging:

- Press the Power bank ON/OFF button(1) to turn on the wireless charging function,the BLUE indicator will be on.
- LED indicator will glow BLUE when in standby mode.
- Place the phone on the wireless charging surface(4).
- The device will automatically begin to charge, LED will flash BLUE when device is charging.
- When the fast charging wireless charging function is started, the BLUE and GREEN lights will be on alternately.

Fast charging will not function when power bank is charging more than 1 device.

Overcharge protection, Overdischarge protection, Overvoltage protection, Overcurrent protection, Short circuit protection are available.

Note: In order to charge devices, use only the accessory cable, or the cable included with your device by the manufacturer.
