

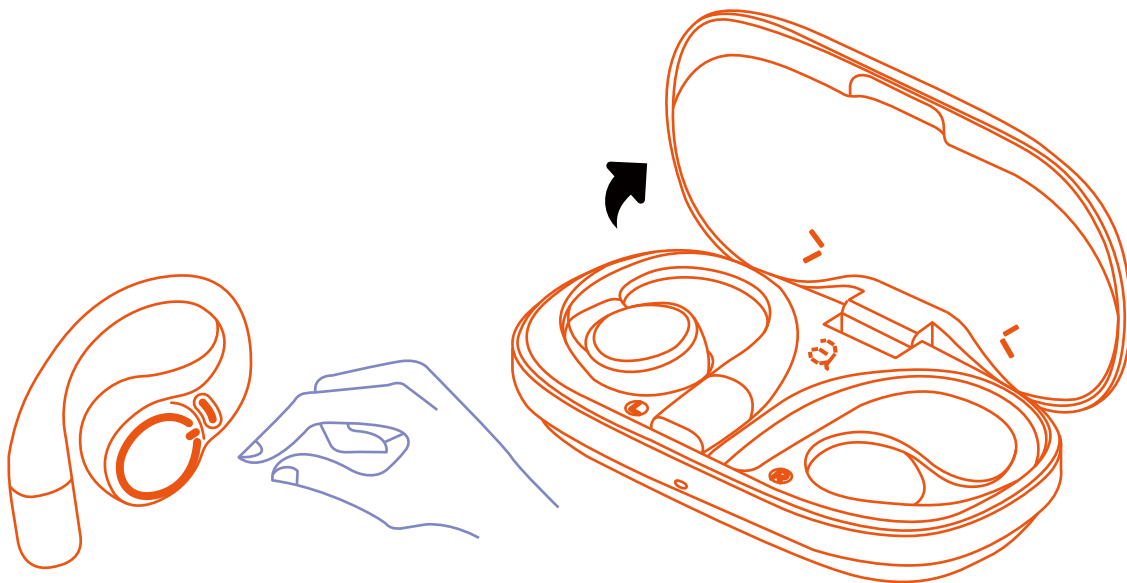

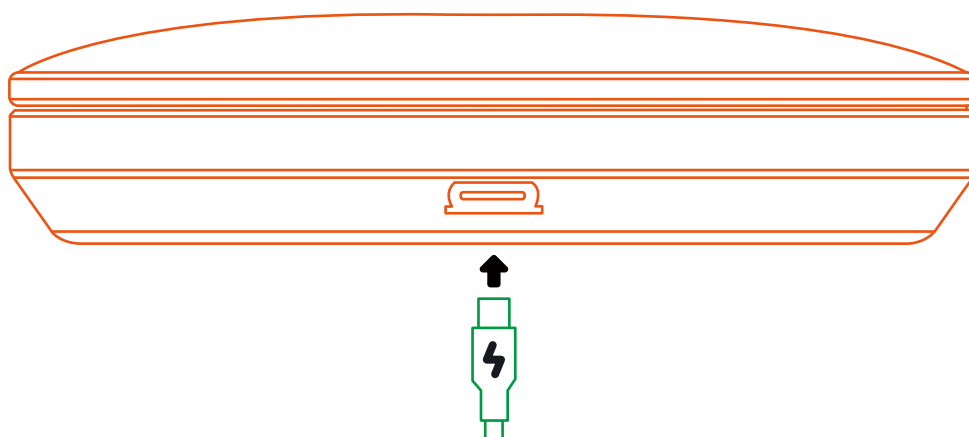

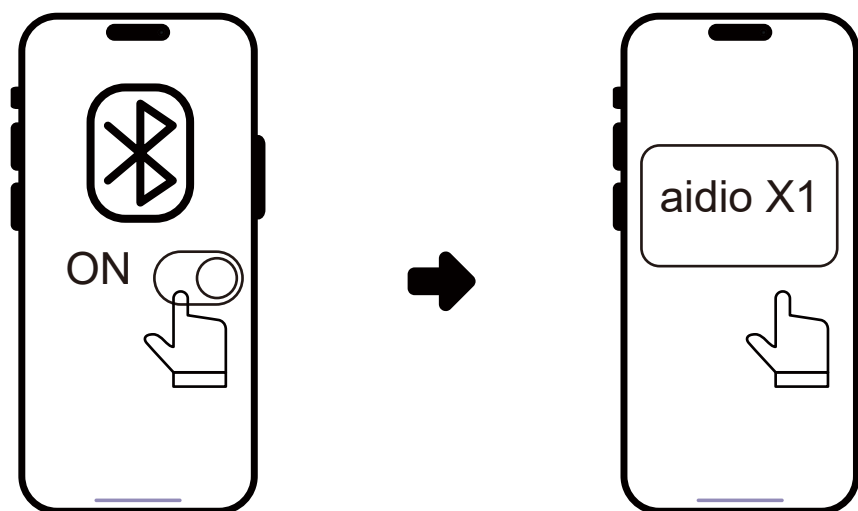
Reminder: Open the charging case upwards.

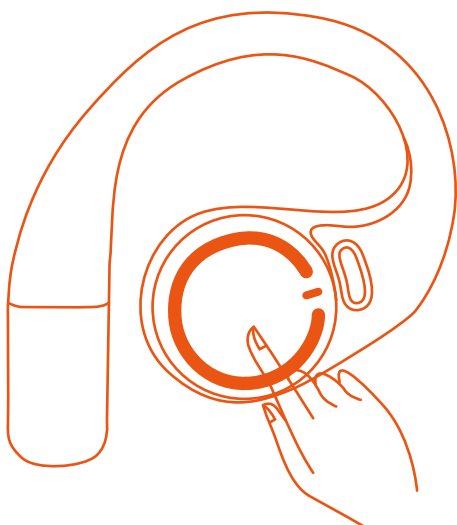
Music play and pause

Switching Songs

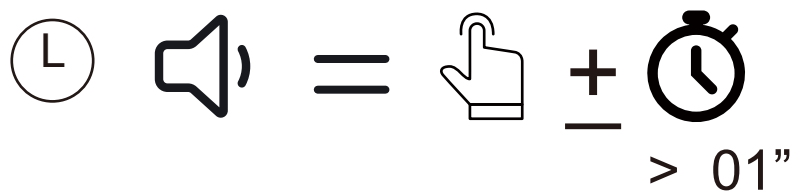
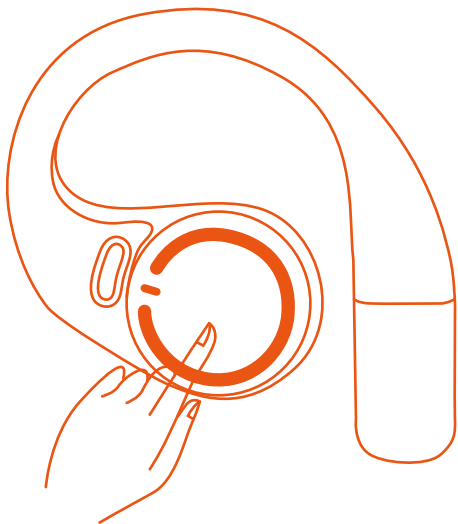


Tap your left ear 3 times to switch

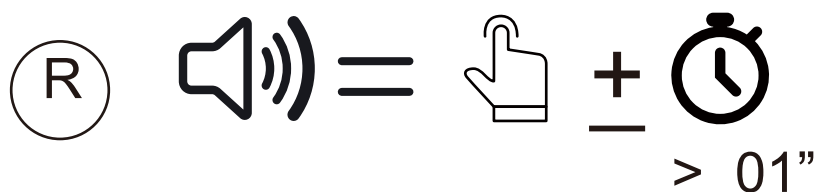
Low volume
