5) Bluetooth connection method

1, You will sound "Welcome WOSAIC" after startup, and the LED indicator will blink

quickly. At the same time, the device that has been connected within the effective distance of

the surrounding area will be searched and automatically connected;

2. Turn on the Bluetooth function of your mobile device (phone, computer and so on) and

search for Bluetooth device "WOSAIC ****";

3. Click it manually, and the device will automatically match and connect. If the connection

is successful, a "Connected" voice will be issued;

4. Devices that have been paired will be automatically connected the next time;

Q: Bluetooth does not automatically connect?

A: Only paired devices will automatically connect, otherwise you can only manually search

and link.
