
Scope of application

Supports most of the DC5V USB input products such as mobilephones, tablets digital devices charging use.

Suggestions:

Since most of the devices are designed for fast charging, it is fastcharger. If 1a (5W) slow charging charger is used,May be due to lackof power, resulting in charging dissatisfaction.



Using steps (Charging a cell phone, for example) :

A .Then put the mobile phone in the middle on the Mobile wireless charging:
