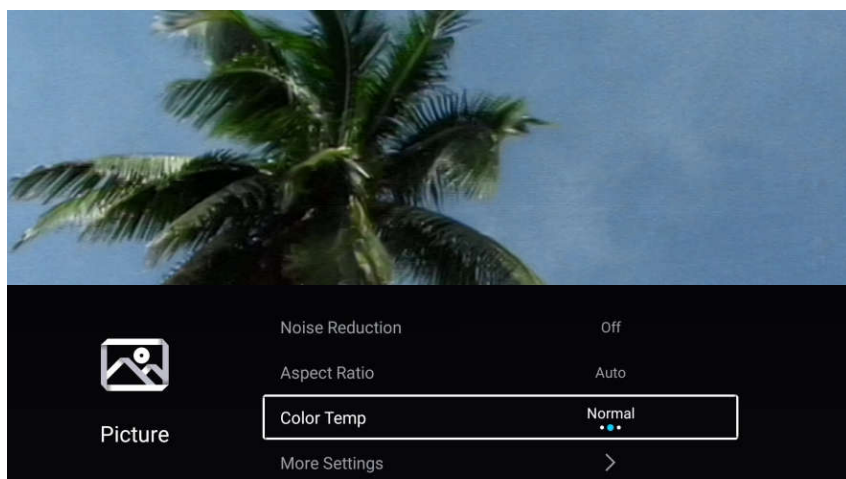
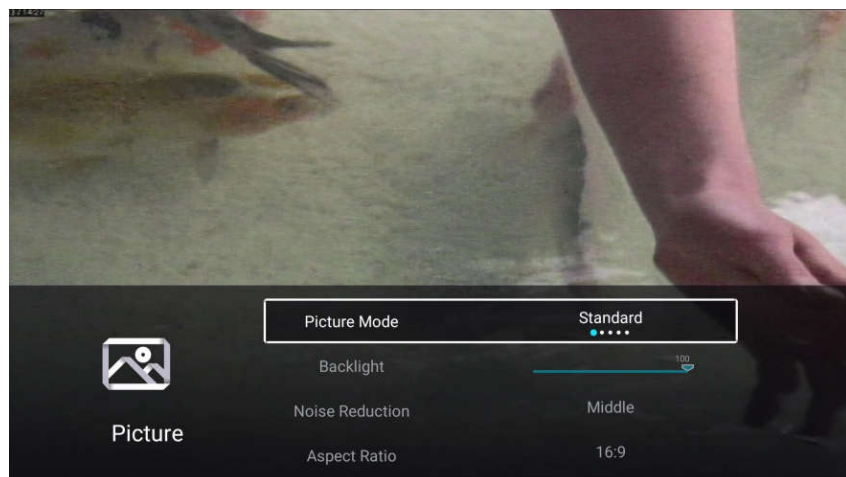


Picture

Picture Mode

Standard	Produces a standard image.
Dynamic	Enhance the contrast ,color and clarity of the screen, so that the picture in the dynamic will balance the color.
Soft	Reduce the screen contrast , color and clarity to make the screen looks soft.
Vivid	Enhance the contrast , color and clarity of the screen to make the color more vivid.
User	Select to customize picture settings.

Contrast/Brightness/Color/Sharpness

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Contrast/Brightness/Color/Sharpness.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Contrast	Adjust the contrast of the image.
Brightness	Adjust the brightness of the image.
Color	Adjust the color intensity of the image.
Sharpness	Adjust the edge sharpness of the image.

Backlight

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Backlight.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Noise Reduction

Set up options to eliminate the image noise intensity.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Noise Reduction.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select Off/Low/Middle/High/Auto.

Aspect Ratio

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Aspect Ratio.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select 16:9/4:3/Zoom1/Zoom2.

Color Temp

Adjust the overall color of the image.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Color Temp.

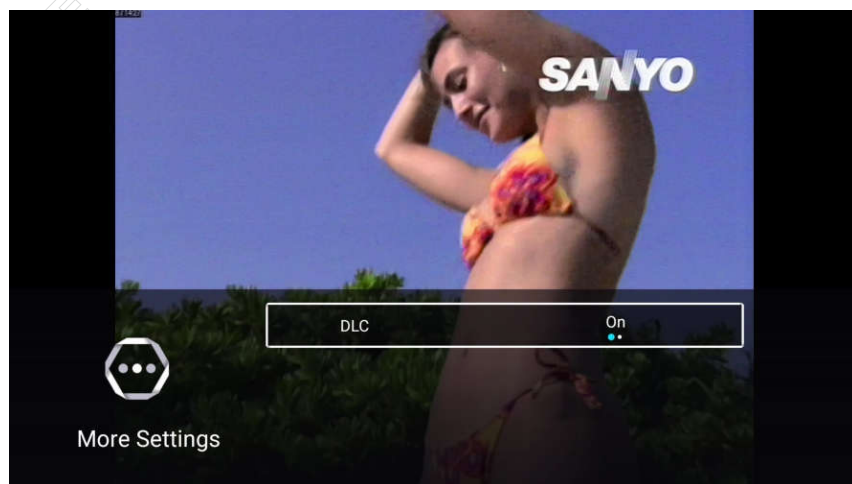
Press ◀ / ▶ button to select Cool/Normal/Warm.

Normal	The picture does not in favor of any color. The color is moderate.
Warm	The picture is in favor of red-green and less blue to make the color more vivid and soft.

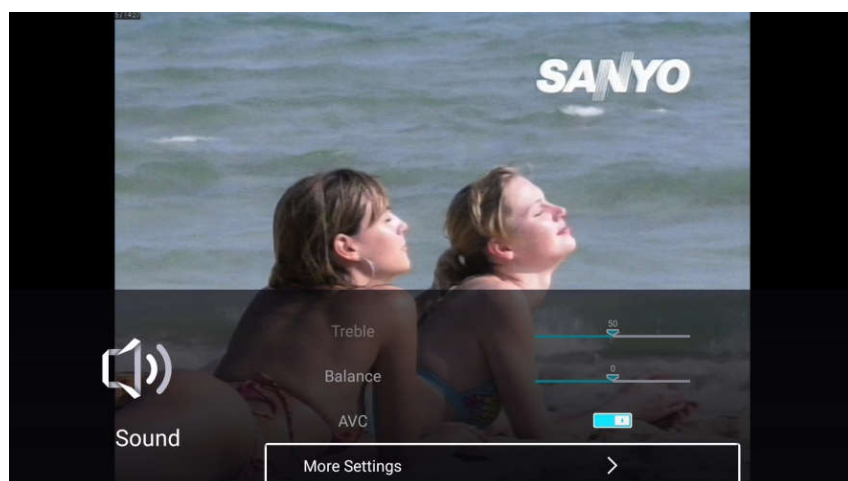
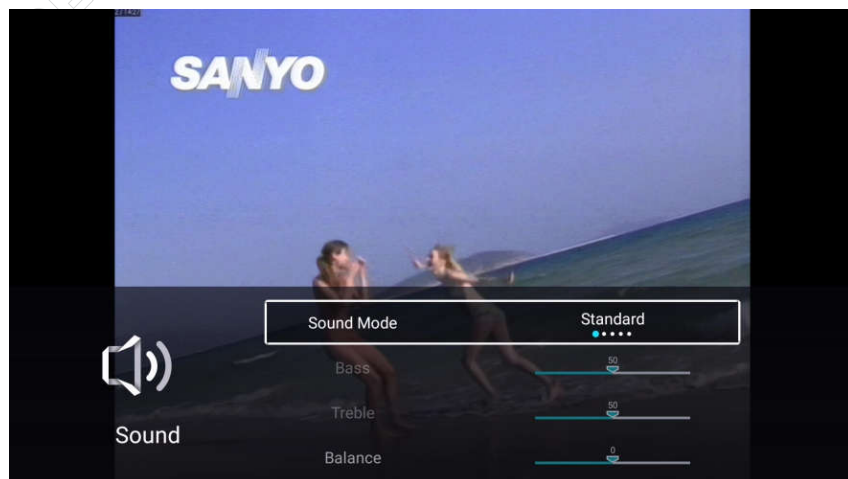

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Bass. Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Treble

Adjust the high frequency sounds.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Treble. Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Blance

Balanced left and right channels.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Balance. Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

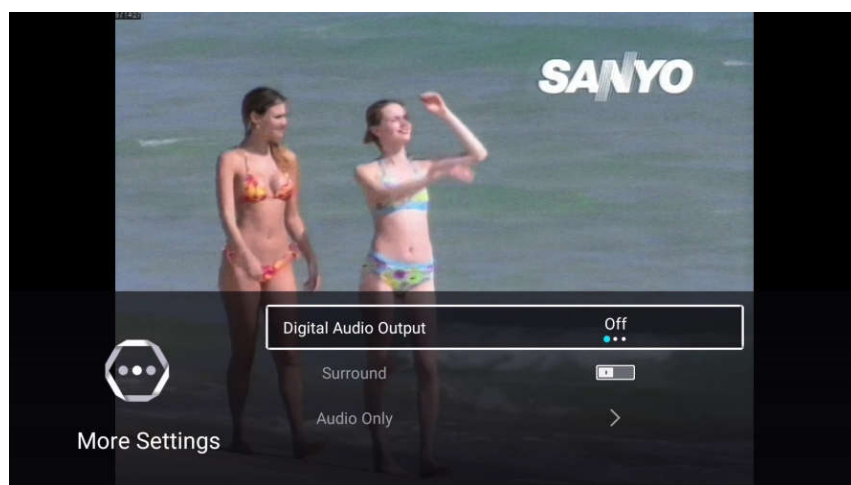
AVC

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select AVC. Press ◀ / ▶ button to select On/Off.

Note: After open the "AVC", once the volume is set up, it can keep the volume of the speaker steady no matter what kind of difference among the TV sound of each channel.

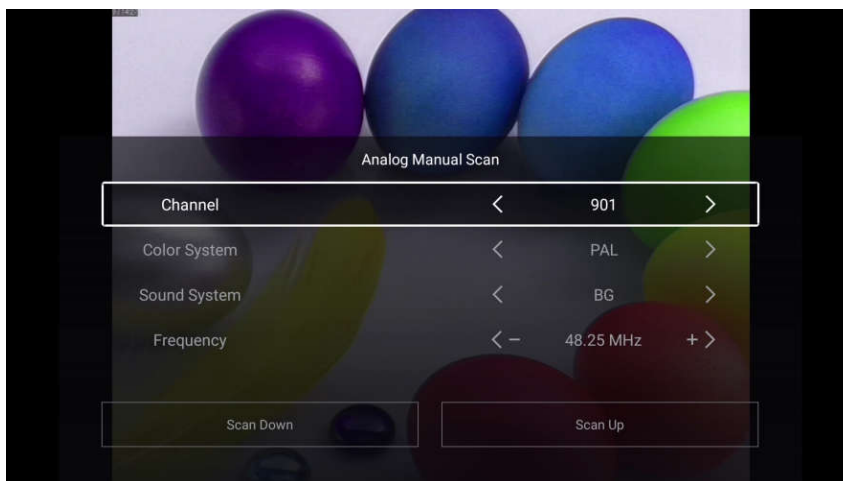

HDMI CEC Setup

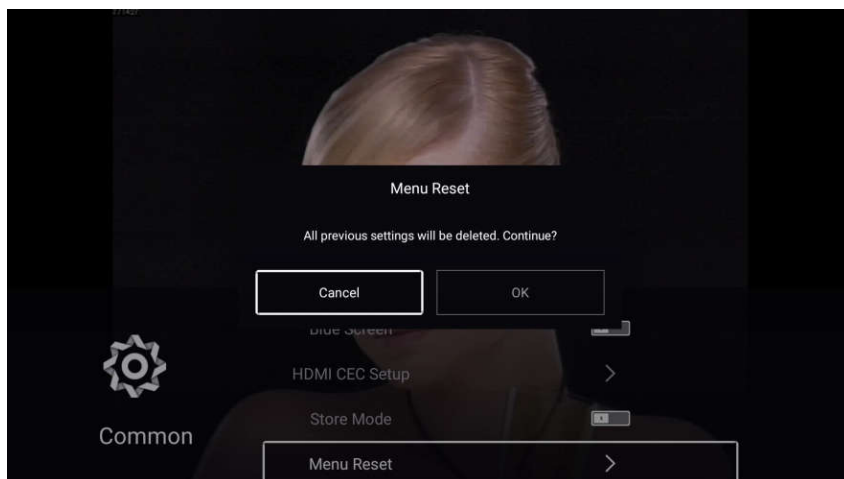
