






Magnetic Holder




A-1 INSTALL THE BATTETRY

1 Use a pen to pry the back cover of the remote



Slightly press the back cover to prevent it from popping out.




A-2 REMOTE CONTROL PARAMETERS

B REMOTE CONTROL PROGRAMMING



B-1 ENTER INTO SETTING MODE



Press and hold "P1" for 5s





The remote lights up and flashes for three times





The channel icon flashes , which means it is in setting mode



It will exit setting mode if there is no action for more than 3 minutes

B-2 SET THE TIME


Please ensure the remote is in setting mode before doing the steps below:



Press and hold "P2" for 5s




The "hour" icon flashes



B-3 SET TIMING

▲ You can set at most 25 groups of timing for each remote





Press and hold "**&**" to add new timing



Press " ◀ " or " ▶ " to select the icon. The selected one will be flashing.



Press "▲" or "▼" to select the numbers.



Press " ◀ " or " ▶ " to select the day of the week. The selected one will be flashing.



Press " • " to save and the icon of "• " will show up. You can select more than one.

Press "▼" to cancel. The icon of "⊕" will not show up if cancelled.



Press "4" or " b" to select the top limit position or bottom limit position. The selected one will be flashing.



Press "▲" to save and the icon of "①" will show up.

Press "▼" to cancel. The icon of "⊕" will not show up if cancelled.



Press " • " or " • " to select the channel number. The selected one will be flashing.



Press "▲" to save and the icon of "⊕" will show up.
You can select more than one.


Press "▼" to cancel. The icon of "⊕" will not show up if cancelled.



Press "♥" to save the setting.



B-4 MODIFY THE GROUP OF TIMINGT




Press "◀" or "▶" to select the group of timing



Press and hold "\(\Omega\)" to enter in the group of timing and modify. The way to modify can be referred by step 3-7 in B-3(P8-P9).

Press " ♥ " & " || "




The motor responds.

Please ensure the remote is in setting mode before doing the steps below:






The motor responds.



B-8 HOW TO ADJUST SHADES RUNNING SPEED

Please ensure the remote is in setting mode before doing the steps below:



2 Speed up



Press " & " & " ▲ "



2 Slow down

Press " & " & " ▼





B-9 HOW TO DELETE THE LIMIT POSITION

Please ensure the remote is in setting mode before doing the steps below:



Press " ◀ " or " ▶ ",
choose the channel number





Press " ▲ " & " ▼



The motor responds.



B-10 HOW TO SET THE LIMIT POSITION

Please ensure the remote is in setting mode before doing the steps below:



Press " ♥ "

Press " ◀ " or " ▶ ", choose the channel number









B-II HOW TO REMOVE ONE CHANNEL

Please ensure the remote is in setting mode before doing the steps below:









All the paired remotes will not be able to control the motor.

B-12 HOW TO RE-PAIR WITH MOTOR

Please ensure the remote is in setting mode before doing the steps below:



Press " ◀ " or " ▶ ", choose the channel number









It shows "H2" on the screen.



Press "P1" x1







It shows "AA" on the screen.
