Boxx warranty

Boxx warrants that the Equipment shall be free from defects in materials or workmanship during the Warranty Period (defined below).

Subject to the exclusions detailed below, if the Equipment fails to conform to this Warranty and the purchaser notifies Boxx in writing within the Warranty Period, Boxx shall, without charge for labour or parts, repair or replace in its sole discretion, the Equipment on the terms and conditions set out below. Where Boxx choose to replace the Equipment, and new Equipment of the relevant model is not available Boxx may replace the Equipment with a refurbished version of that model. In the event that neither new nor a refurbished model is available, Boxx will use its reasonable endeavours to supply a like for like replacement. Where Boxx chooses to repair the Equipment Boxx requires the purchaser to return the same to Boxx at the purchaser's expense.

Warranty period:
The warranty period is one (1) year from the date of purchase by the original end-user customer, unless:

1. An exceptional warranty period applying to the Equipment or a component part thereof is published on the Boxx website
2. The Equipment has been repaired or replaced under warranty, in which case the warranty applies until the end of the original warranty period, or six (6) months from the date of such repair or replacement, whichever is longer.

Warranty claims and validation:
The purchaser presenting to Boxx (either via the properly authorised Boxx dealer from whom the product was purchased or by contacting Boxx directly at the address stated below) the original sales invoice (indicating the date of purchase by the original end-user customer, serial number and the original dealer's name) together with the defective Equipment within the Warranty Period; and inspection by Boxx (or its authorised service agent) disclosing to the satisfaction of Boxx that:

1. The defect in the Equipment has arisen from defects in workmanship or materials during the Warranty Period.
2. None of the exclusions apply.

Handling.
Always use the Punch pads with caution and care. Housed inside all elements are fragile electronic components that can be damaged if not used correctly, this includes if the product is dis-assembled, punctured, dropped or exposed to heat or liquid. Do not use the product if damaged, including broken or faulty Punch Pads. Do not replace the Punch Pad batteries or interfere with the power source of the product in any way, tampering with the product can cause overheating or injury. Do not expose this product to fire, microwaves, high temperatures or direct sunlight.

Charging.
Only use the charge cable provided with the Punch Pads at purchase, other charging cables or apparatus may not be compliant with international and regional regulations and could pose a risk of injury or death. Using damaged cables or power adapters, can cause fire or injury and damage to the device or other property. To maximise the longevity of the glove wraps Boxx recommends hand washing the fabric in warm water. Please avoid hot machine washing the glove wraps as this may result in damage or malfunction. Additional care:

- If required, please clean the Punch Pads with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use any form of cleaning substance or liquid as this may result in product faults or damage.
- Always clear a safe space before undertaking a Boxx workout or using the Punch Pads, failure to do so may result in injury or property damage.
- When using a punch bag whilst using the Punch Pads, always wear boxing gloves on top of the provided glove wraps.
