To Whom It May Concern:

In support of the request for FCC long term confidentiality of the FCC submission exhibits mentioned below, as per KDB 726920 Section II, DroneShield LLC (“the applicant”) provides supporting rationale for the following requests:

Internal Photo Long Term Confidentiality

As the product is a scanning receiver, rationale is not required for Internal Photos as per KDB 726920 Section II 1b). For scanning receivers, it is automatic without request.

User Manual Long Term Confidentiality

The User Manual supplied (*CONF_[DRO-124] DroneSentry-X Mk2_DO_Manual_v2.6.pdf*) for the submission contains privileged information on the operation of our goods, which: is **not** publicly available; is a trade secret only available to our users and partners; and contains proprietary technical information intended for professional technicians and operators obligated under an NDA. All professional technicians and operators must agree to comply with our [EULA](#) when handling the User Manual, which contains these non-disclosure obligations and is a form of NDA. Please see the definition of “Documentation”, which specifically refers to “user manuals”.

We note that our goods are used in active warzones and other sensitive military operations. If the information set out within our User Manual remains publicly available, this could be utilized by adversaries to develop countermeasures to our goods. This would diminish the efficacy and defense potential of our products.
