GETTING STARTED

Installing the Memory Card

Insert the memory card with the gold contacts facing to the front of the device. Push the memory card until it clicks into place.

About SD Card

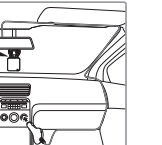
- Please use SD card with the size/memory at least 4GB, Class 6 (up to 32GB).
- Be sure to format SD card using the device before the initial usage.
- Do not remove the memory card while recording. This may damage the memory card.

Charging the Battery

1. Connect one end of the USB cable to the micro USB port of the device.
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to the computer.

NOTE

- If you using the device as a car recorder, use the car adapter to charge the battery.



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INITIAL SETUP

Turning the Device On/Off

- Turn on the power, press the **POWER** button.
- Turn off the power, press and hold the **POWER** button for at least 5 seconds.

Installing Wirecorder APP

1. Make sure your smartphone is connected to the Internet.
2. Launch **Play Store** (Android) or **App Store** (iOS) application.
3. On the search bar, enter the keyword “wirecorder” to search for APP.
4. Download and install Wirecorder. After the installation is complete, the Wirecorder icon () is displayed on the application screen.

NOTE

- The application UI varies depending on the device operating system and design.

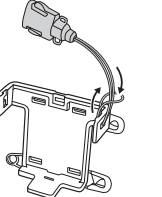
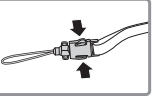


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USING NECK STRAP

To use the neck strap, do the following:

1. Press the quick release buckle to detach the small piece of neck straps that consists of a small lanyard.
2. Insert the lanyard through the strap eyelet on the bracket. Make a loop to secure it.
3. Install the camera into the bracket.
4. Attach the quick release buckle onto its slot (see Step 1 illustration). Press the buckle firmly until it snaps into place.
5. Wear the neck strap.



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USING CLOTHESPIN BRACKET

To wear the device on your cloth using the clothespin bracket, do the following:

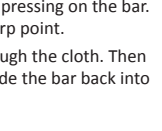
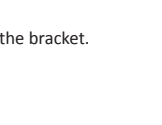
1. Install the camera into the bracket.
2. Pinch the prongs to open the clipper and wear it on your cloth.



USING SAFETY PIN BRACKET

To wear the device on your cloth using the safety pin bracket, do the following:

1. Install the camera into the bracket.
2. Open the safety pin by pressing on the bar. Be careful with the sharp point.
3. Slide the open pin through the cloth. Then squeeze the pin and slide the bar back into position.



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USING CAR BRACKET

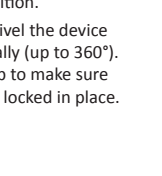
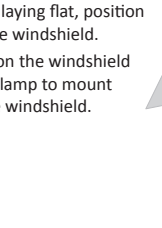
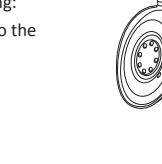
The device can be used as a car recorder. To mount the device in your car, do the following:

1. Install the camera into the bracket.



2. With the suction-cup laying flat, position the suction cup on the windshield.
3. Hold the base firmly on the windshield and press down the clamp to mount the car bracket to the windshield.

4. Adjust the device position. Loose the knob to swivel the device vertically or horizontally (up to 360°). Then tighten the knob to make sure the device is securely locked in place.

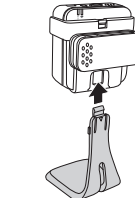


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USING STAND

The device can also be used as a surveillance camera to monitor your home or office. To attach the stand, do the following:

1. Install the camera into the bracket. Then install the stand to the slot on the bracket.
2. Place the stand on a stable surface.



CONNECTING TO SMARTPHONE

1. On your smartphone, launch **Settings** application.
2. In **WIRELESS & NETWORKS**, tap **Wi-Fi** and set it to **ON**. The available networks are listed.
3. Tap **TESTAP** to connect to the camera.
4. Enter the password and tap **Connect**.

NOTE


- The default password is “111111111”.
- You can change the SSID and password in Setup mode.

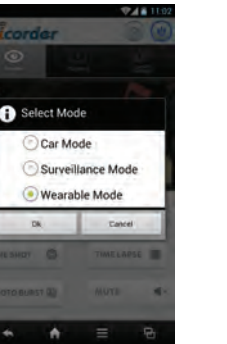


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MODE SELECTION

Selecting the Mode


1. Launch **Wirecorder** application.
2. Tap  or the Back key to display the **Select Mode** menu.
3. Select the desired mode that you want to use.
 - **Car Mode:** Select this option to use the device as a car recorder.
 - **Surveillance Mode:** Select this option to use the device as a surveillance camera.
 - **Wearable Mode:** Select this option to use the device to manually record videos or capture photos.
4. Tap **Ok** to confirm.



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PREVIEW MODE

Viewing Live View

1. Tap **Preview** tab to switch to Preview/Record mode.
2. Tap  to view the live view on your smartphone.



NOTE

- Hold your smartphone horizontally to view the live view in full screen.

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RECORD MODE

Recording Videos

- To start recording video, tap **RECORDING**. The text and icon turn red.
- To stop recording, tap **RECORDING** again.

NOTE

- To disable the voice recording, tap **MUTE**.
- You can also press the **SHUTTER** button on the camera to start/stop recording video.



Capturing Photos

Tap **ONE SHOT** to capture a photo. You can also press the **SHUTTER** button on the camera to capture a photo.

Capturing Continuous Shots

Tap and hold **PHOTO BURST** to continuously capture photos. Release **PHOTO BURST** to stop shooting.



Capturing Photos By Time Lapse Mode

Tap **TIME LAPSE** to continuously capture photos at the preset interval time. Tap **TIME LAPSE** again to stop shooting.

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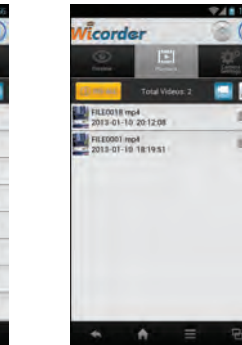
PLAYBACK MODE

Tap **Playback** tab to switch to Playback mode.

Tap  or  to browse the recorded files.

Videos

Tap any thumbnail to view the image in full screen.

NOTE

- To delete any recorded file, tap  on the respective file name. A confirmation message appears on the screen, tap **Yes** to confirm file deletion.

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Playing Videos

1. On **Videos** list, tap the desired video to play the video.




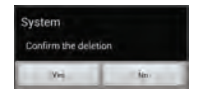
2. Tap the screen to pause the playback. Tap the screen again to resume the video playback.

Viewing Photo

On **Photos** list, tap the desired photo that you want to view.

Delete File

On the playback screen, tap  to delete the current file. A confirmation message appears on the screen, tap **Yes** to confirm file deletion.



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Downloading File into Your Smartphone

On the playback screen, tap **Download** () to save the selected file into your smartphone.

Sharing File to Facebook / YouTube

Before sharing the file to Facebook or YouTube, download the desired file first into your smartphone.



1. Tap  or  to share your file and disconnect the Wi-Fi connection between the device and your smartphone. Tap **Ok** to continue.
2. Connect your smartphone to the Internet (either by mobile data connection or Wi-Fi). Then launch **Wirecorder** application.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to login to your social network account.

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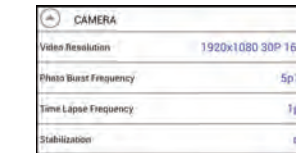
SETUP MODE

1. Tap **Camera Settings** tab to switch to Setup mode.
2. Tap the desired menu category and select the menu option.
3. Tap to select the desired setting.



CAMERA

Configure the video and photo recording settings.

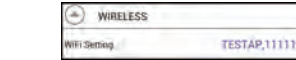


- **Video Resolution:** Set the video resolution.
- **Photo Burst Frequency:** Specify the number of continuous shots per second.
- **Time Lapse Frequency:** Select the interval options when capturing photos using Lapse mode.
- **Stabilization:** Select **on** to enable the stabilizer function.

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WIRELESS

Configure the wireless connection settings.

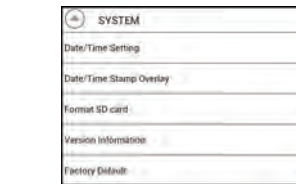


- **WiFi Setting:** Configure the SSID and password settings. Enter the new SSID and password. Then tap **Save** to save the settings.



SYSTEM

Configure the device general settings.



- **Date/Time Setting:** View the current date and time.
- **Date/Time Stamp Overlay:** Select **on** to include a date and time on a video stream.
- **Format SD card:** Select **yes** to format the memory card installed on the device.
- **Version Information:** View the model name and firmware version.
- **Factory Default:** Select **yes** to reset all settings to factory default settings.
