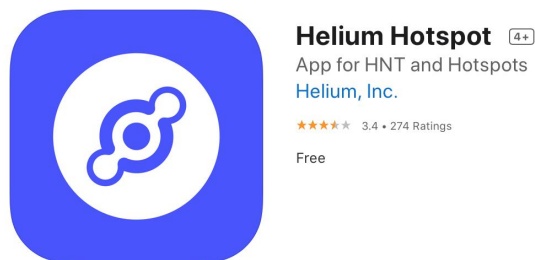

Please download “Helium Hotspot” on iTunes App Store or the Google Play Store

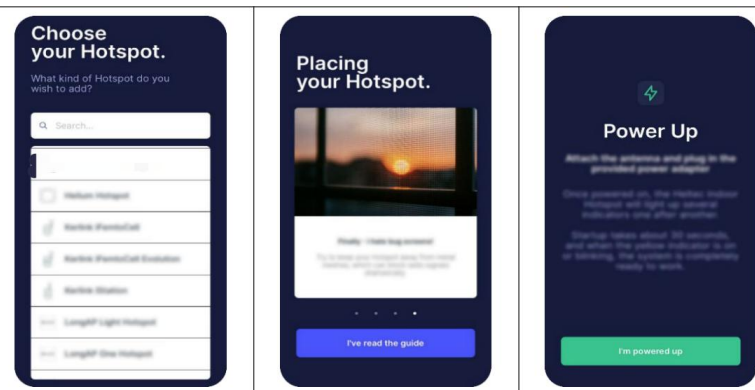


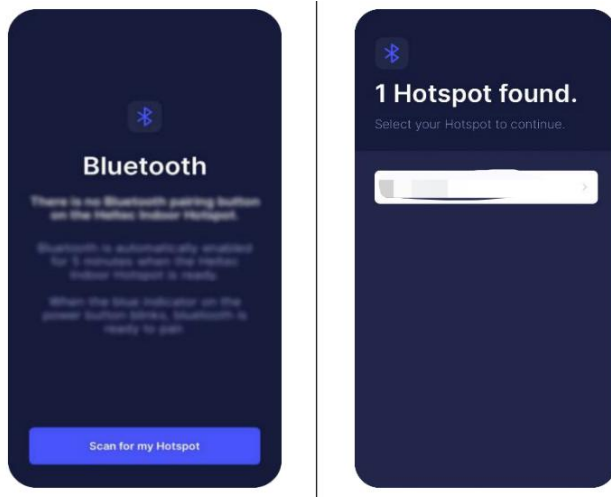
## 2.Connect accessories with GatorPro.

## 3.Use helium APP to connect GatorPro

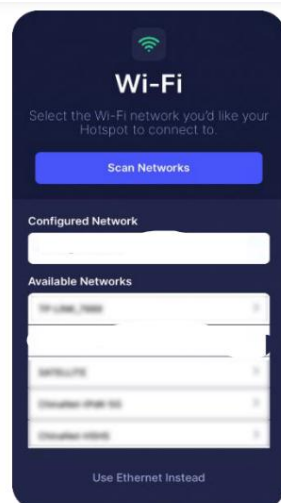
Switch your phone's Bluetooth on and Click helium APP,,click “Scan for my Hotspot” from the Bluetooth page and then connect to GatorPro,
