

Installation requires special training of professional installers. The product can only be repaired by fastback and has tamper seals. Please refer to the Installation Manual provided as part of this Application Sections 2.1 which explains breaking the tamper seals voids the warranty and 6.3.1 which explains to mount where access is restricted to authorized service personnel.

In additional to above mentioned documents, pursuant to Public Notice DA 04-1705 of the Commission's policy, in order to comply with the marketing regulations in 47 CFR §2.803 and the importation rules in 47 CFR §2.1204, while ensuring that business sensitive information remains confidential until the actual marketing of newly authorized devices.
