

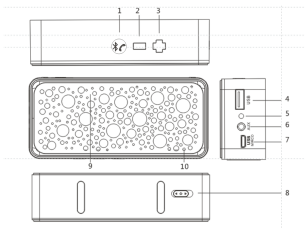

Caution

1. Signal transfer by wireless Bluetooth EDR with v2.1.
For clear sound quality, please do not put your BeatCharge near home appliances like microwave oven, TV and amplifier.
2. The BeatCharge is not waterproof and not fireproof.
Keep it away from water and from high temperatures and fire.
3. When not in use please turn the power of your BeatCharge off.

Connecting to your BeatCharge via Bluetooth

1. Turn on the Bluetooth function of your Bluetooth device/smartphone so that it is searching for new Bluetooth devices.
2. Turn on your Beatcharge, it will beep.
3. Press and hold the  button for approx. 5 seconds to activate Bluetooth pairing. Your BeatCharge will beep, and then the LED indicator (Bluetooth status indicator) will flash blue continuously. If not, please check whether there is any other Bluetooth device connected with your BeatCharge and turn off such other Bluetooth device.
4. Search for your BeatCharge with your Bluetooth device/smartphone and you should see "BeatCharge". Select it and pairing will commence. Enter password "0000" if requested. When paired, your BeatCharge will beep and the LED indicator will regularly flash blue at 5-second intervals(approx.).

Charging your BeatCharge

About once a month, fully charge your BeatCharge (about 4 hours) or charge it to full charge when it has run out of power.

1. Plug the charging cable supplied with your BeatCharge into your BeatCharge's Micro USB charging port and then into the USB socket of your PC/MAC or wall socket power adapter.
2. If you will use your PC/MAC for charging your BeatCharge make sure that your PC/MAC is powered ON.

Charging your Smartphone with your BeatCharge

1. Make sure that your BeatCharge is turned on and that your BeatCharge is fully/well charged.
2. Connect the charging cable of your Smartphone to the USB port of your BeatCharge and then connect to your Smartphone. Your Smartphone will start charging.
3. You can charge your Smartphone and play music with your BeatCharge simultaneously.

Status indicator for charging your BeatCharge

Red light = Charging

Blue light = Fully charged

Connecting to your BeatCharge via 3.5mm audio cable (AUX IN)

1. Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to your Smartphone and then to the AUX IN input of your BeatCharge. The Bluetooth status indicator will turn red and your BeatCharge will turn off the Bluetooth connection.
2. Note that in AUX IN connection mode the Play and Volume controls of your BeatCharge are not operative.

Troubleshooting

My BeatCharge doesn't work or it won't pair

- Try moving your Smartphone closer.
- Please check whether there is any other Bluetooth device connected with your BeatCharge and turn off such other Bluetooth device.
- Is your BeatCharge turned on and charged?
- Turn your Beatcharge off and then on to reset it.
- Is Bluetooth enabled on your device or computer?
- Try repeating the setup procedure in this guide or pair with a different Bluetooth device.
- Your BeatCharge plays music from one device at a time. Unpair the device not being used and pair a new device using the setup procedure to play music from the new device.

Battery Safety Warnings

1. If this BeatCharge is intended by the Purchaser to be used by a minor, purchasing adult agrees to provide detailed instructions and warnings to any minor prior to use. What is covered by the limited warranty:
