Dear FCC Office of Engineering and Technology (OET) Laboratory Division, Is it possible for the manufacturer of a cellular module to have two different FCC IDs for the same module (identical hardware and software), for commercial reasons?

Essentially, they intend to sell the module (with FCC ID: XXXabcde) to host manufacturer A, who will label it with ?Contains FCC ID: XXXabcde.? They also plan to sell the same module to another host manufacturer B, but with a different FCC ID: XXXfghij. Manufacturer B would label it with ?Contains FCC ID: XXXfghij.?

If this is possible, we believe the appropriate procedure would be to apply the KDB for Referencing Test Data, and we assume no additional testing would be required for this process.

We would appreciate your advice.
