

User Manual

- 1,When using,connect the audio cable provided to your external device.(fig.1)
- 2,Switch on the mini speaker using the on/off button located underneath the speaker.(fig.2)
- 3,LED light will turn red once the speaker is switched on.(fig.3)
- 4,Enjoy up to 6 hours of playing time;For charging,use the USB cable provided and charge with computer.
- 5,Use your external device to change volume,song choice etc.

Note:

- Ensure that your mini spekaer is switched off when charging.
- To fully maximized the battery life,use up the battery fully before re-charging and charge the speaker fully before playing.

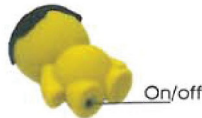
