Press wallpaper button and choose:



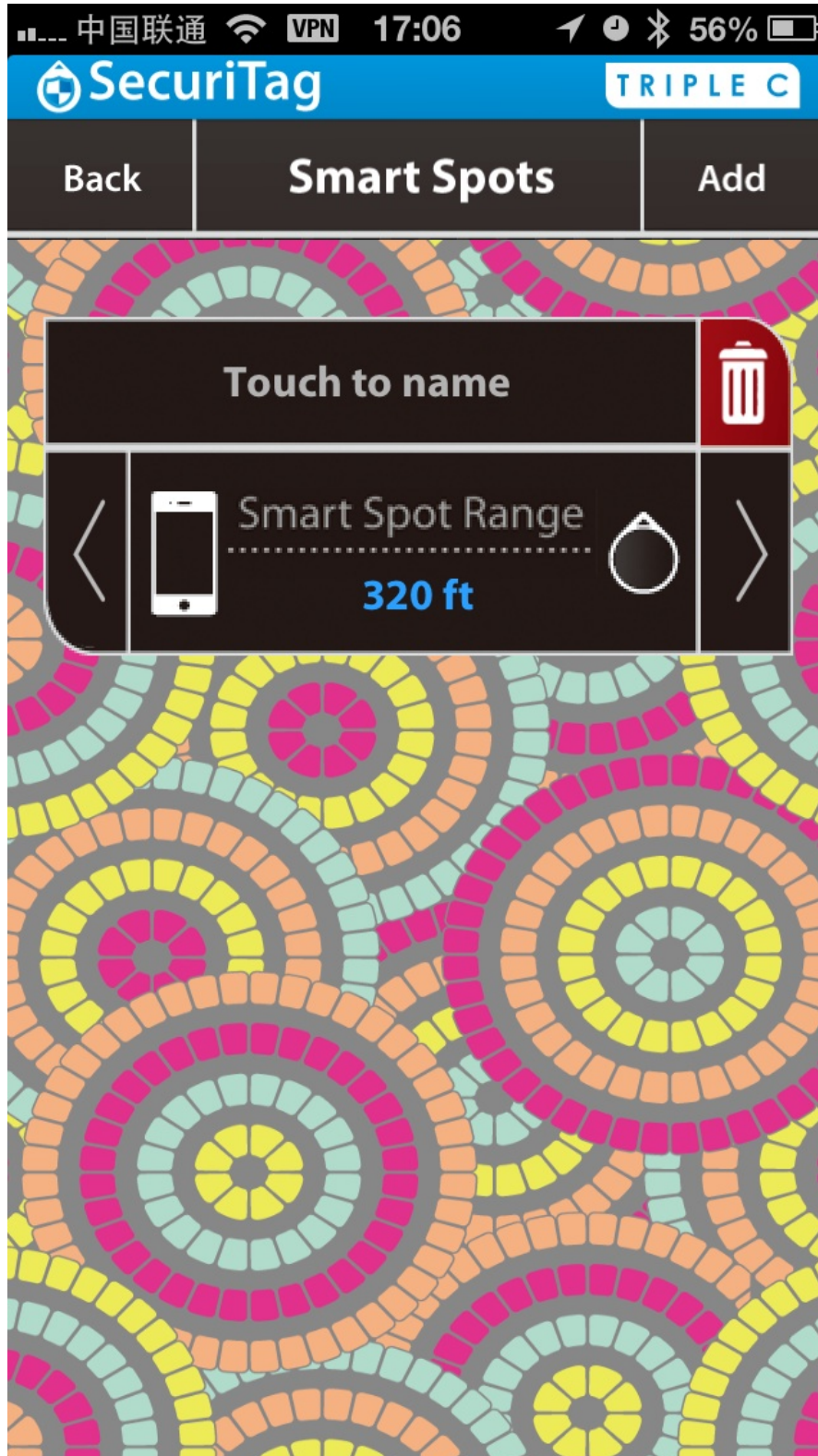

Smart Spot Setting:

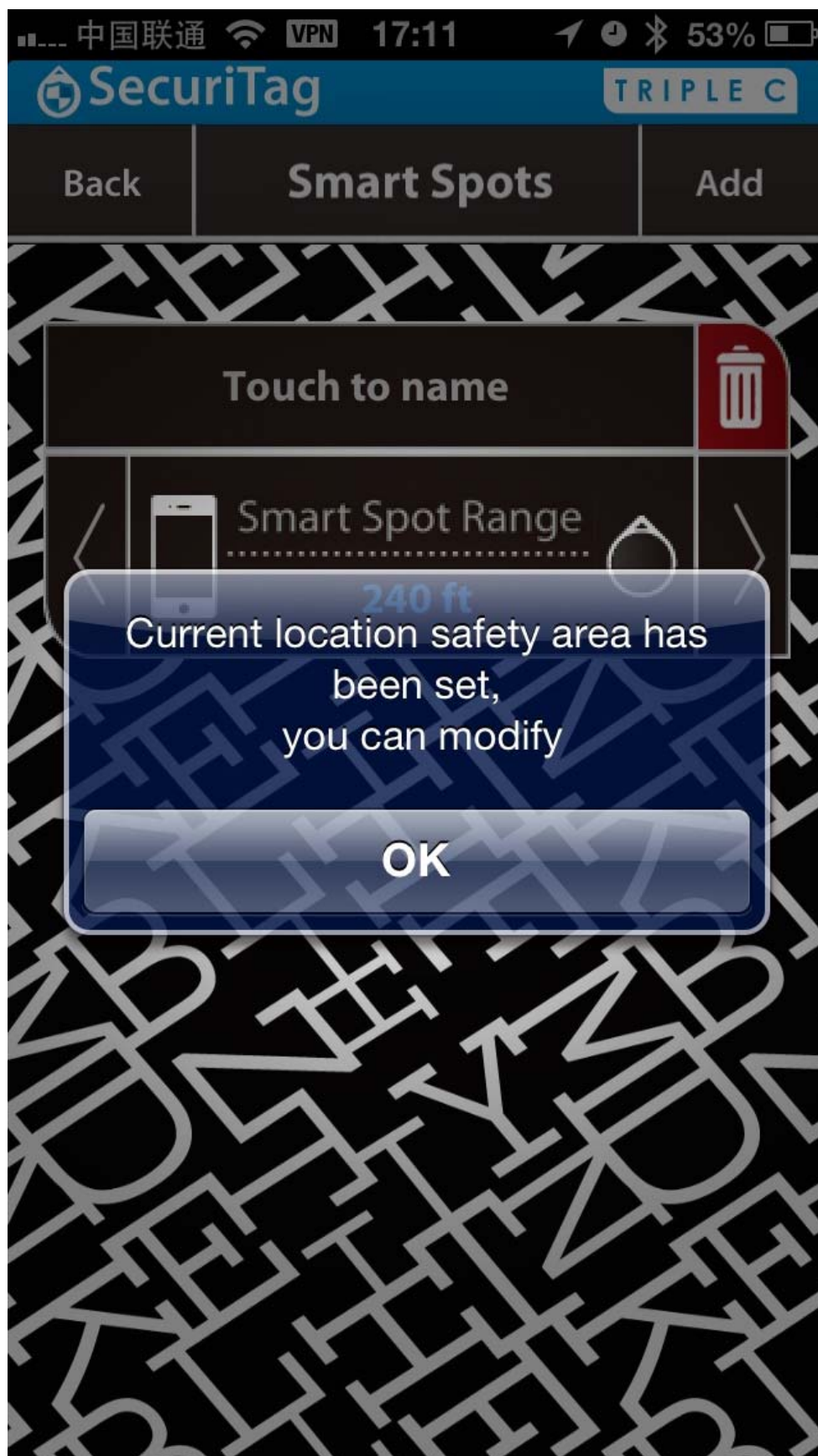

After Smart Spot setting, you will see green radius on setting page map.

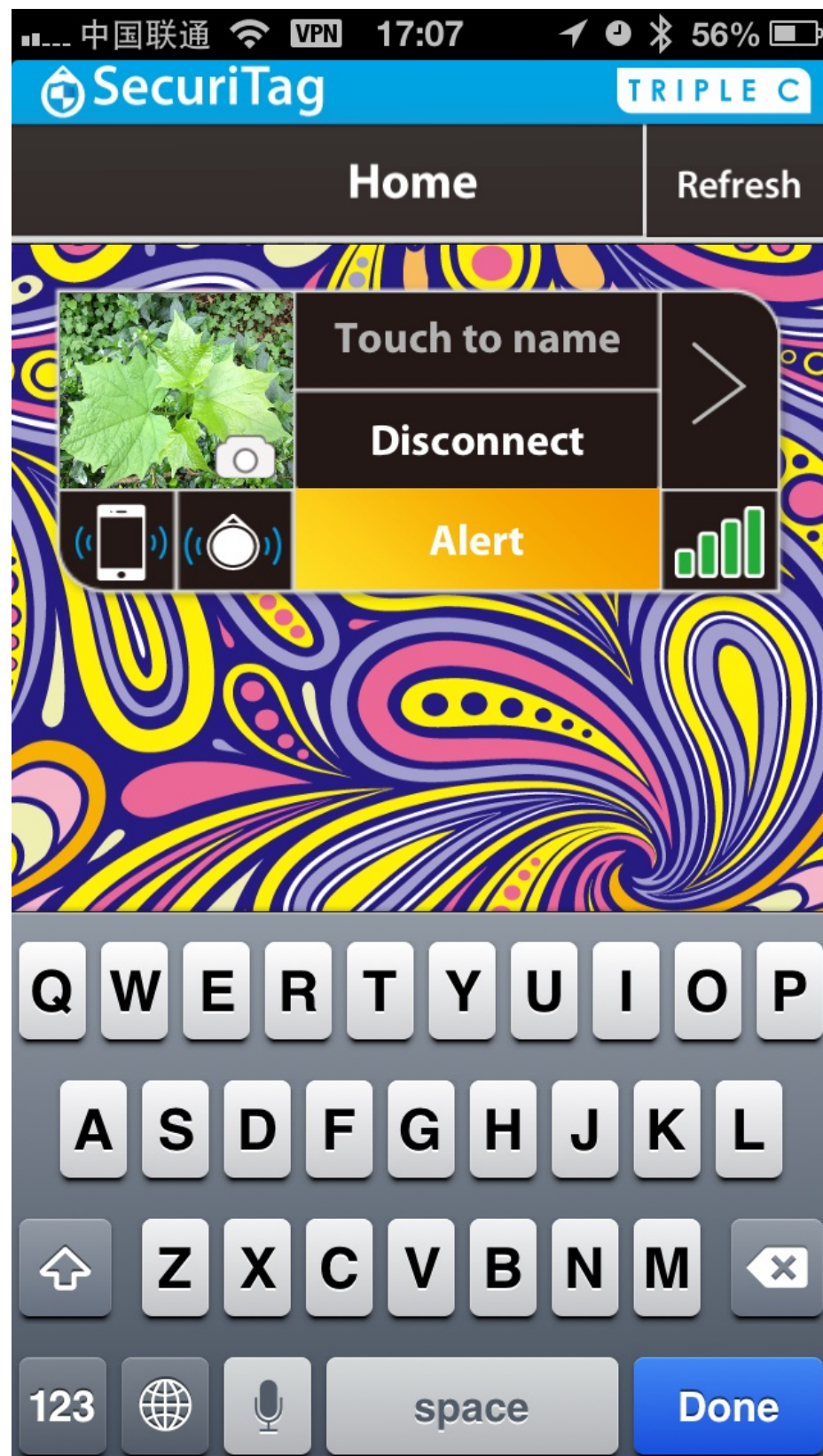


Only one smart spot can be set at one location



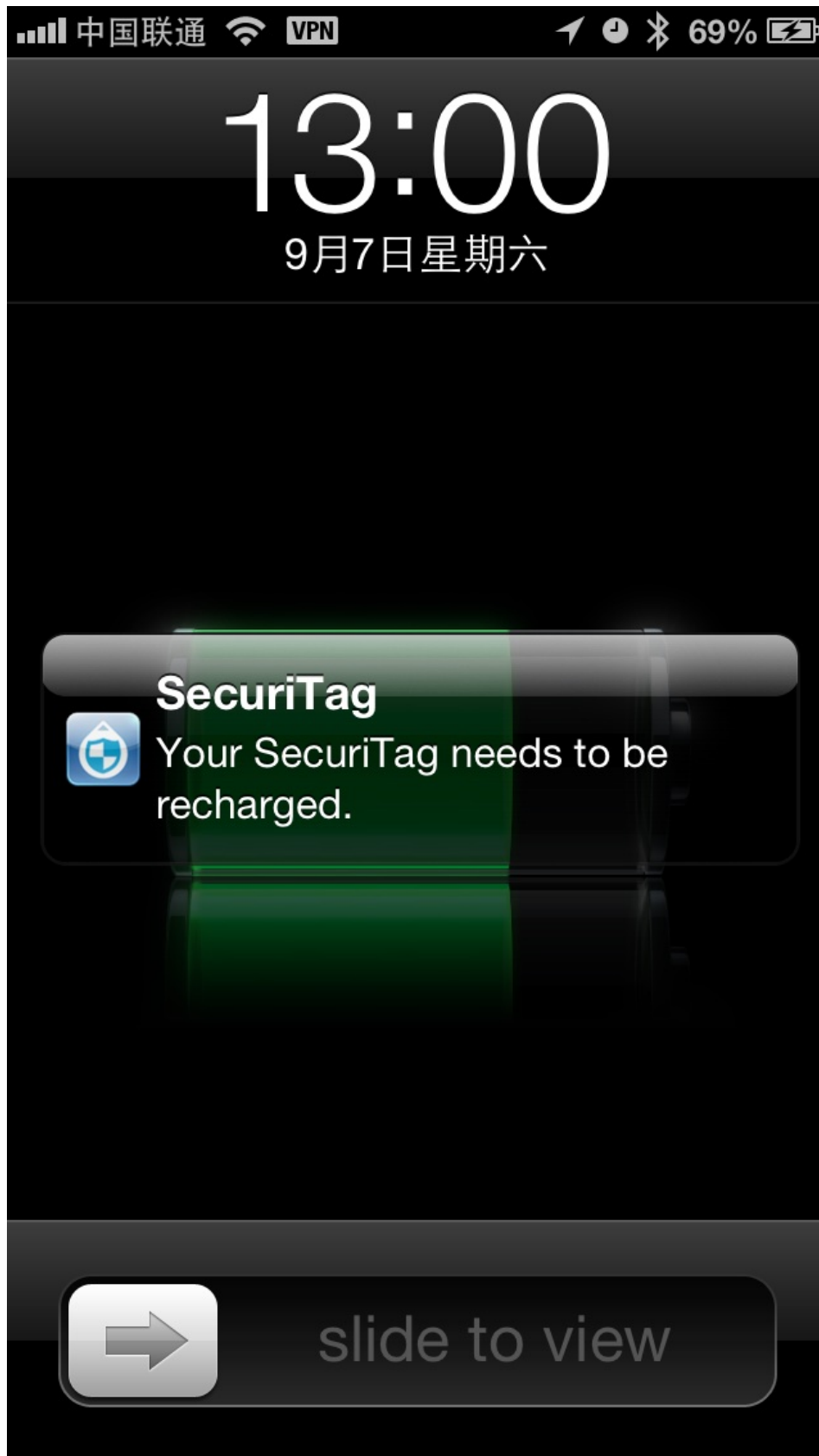
Renaming:
