User manual</li> </ol> <p><b>CHARGING YOUR BLUCUBE+:</b></p> <p>Your speaker uses a rechargeable battery, full charge battery before using, please turn off before charging.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Use the USB cable provided to connect to any computer or power adapter. When charging, 3 LED lights will indicate the battery life. Red, means power less than 33% , blue, means power approx. 33%~66%, green, means power approx. 66%~100%</li> <li>2. When fully charged, the green keeps on.</li> </ol>	<p>Charging time: approximately 3 hours. Turn speaker off when not use to save battery life.</p> <p><b>PAIRING DEVICE WITH YOUR BLUCUBE +:</b></p> <p>Before using the speaker, please pair it with your smartphone, mp3 player, computer or any Bluetooth-enabled device. Set your Bluetooth device to discover the BluCUBE by following the instruction manual for your device. Typically the steps are going to "Setup", "connect" or "Bluetooth" menu and then selection to discover Bluetooth devices.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Turn the speaker on. Speaker will automatically begin pairing. LED indicator light will flash quickly base on the battery life.</li> <li>2. When your Bluetooth-enabled device</li> </ol>	<p>discovers the speaker , press "OK" to pair with the speaker , indicator light will switch to slow blinking toe indicate pairing is successful.</p> <p><b>TROUBLESHOOTING:</b></p> <p>If your Bluetooth-enabled device fails locate the speaker, check that the speaker is ON. Ensure that your device is within range (within 30 feet/10 meters). Restart your speaker to reactivate Bluetooth pairing mode. Ensure that your speaker is not connected or paired to any other Bluetooth device as the BluCUBE can only be paired to on device at a time.</p> <p><b>Playing music /answering calls/ selfie:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. After pairing is established, you can play music from your Bluetooth-enabled device.</li> </ol>
