How to use it?

Step 1: Plug in Evaife light

Connect the included power cable to the port on the device. Plug the opposite end into a power outlet. Always keep your device plugged in.

Step 2: Power on

Press the Power button to power on the device. The clock display will light up.

Step 3: Download the Evaife mobile app

Download the Evaife mobile app on your smartphone and create an account.



Step 4: Complete setup

Follow the steps in the Evaife app to connect your device. Bluetooth must be enabled.

Note: Bluetooth is on by default. When the device is powered on, the Bluetooth indicator will display a blue light.

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APP re-pairing: To reconnect or connect to a new Bluetooth device, press and hold the Bluetooth button for 5 seconds to reset the setting. And the Bluetooth indicator will flash three times.

Step 5: Light it up

To turn on the light and speaker, touch and hold the Touch Sensor for 3 seconds. The light can also be controlled using the mobile app

APP Control

Steps to play music via Bluetooth:
1. Select "BT speaker mode" in the mobile app.
2. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your smartphone, and search and connect to the "Evaife speaker."
Now you can turn on your phone's music player to play music through the speaker.

Note: Select any white noise option in the mobile app to switch the white noise channel.

Create a sleep routine

Personalize a sleep routine to fit your child's bedtime schedule and let them know when it's time to get up and go to sleep.

Click the "Scene" icon to enter the scene list.

Then click the "+" icon to add a new scene.

Create shortcut mode

Note: The default Shortcut Mode is warm light without sound.

Click the "Scene" icon in the mobile app to enter the scene list.

Then click the Shortcut button to create a frequently used scene.

Press the Shortcut button to quickly turn on/off Shortcut Mode.

Step 6: Turn the light and speaker off

Touch and hold the Touch Sensor for 3 seconds or use the mobile app to turn off the light and speaker.

Unplug Evaife before cleaning. Clean the surface with a damp cloth, avoiding the power charging port.
CAUTION: Evaife may be damaged if the power charging port comes into contact with liquid.
