

## APPENDIX D – Maximum Permissible Exposure

### RF Exposure Limit

According to FCC 1.1310: The criteria listed in the following table shall be used to evaluate the Environmental of human exposure to radio frequency (RF) radiation as specified in 1.1307(b)

### Fries formula

Fries transmission formula :  $P_d = (P_{out} * G) / (4 * \pi * r^2)$

$$r = \sqrt{((P_{out} * G) / 4 * \pi * P_d)}$$

Where

$P_d$  = Power density in  $\text{mW/cm}^2$

$P_{out}$  = Output power to antenna in  $\text{mW}$

$G$  = Gain of antenna in linear scale

$\pi = 3.1416$

$r$  = Distance between observation point center of the radiator in cm

$P_d$  is the limit of MPE,  $1 \text{ mW/cm}^2$ . If we know the Maximum Gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the Maximum distance  $r$  where the MPE limit is reached and Power density at prediction frequency.

**Test Result :**

The maximum antenna gain is **2.9 dBi**.

Maximum conducted output power at antenna input terminal: 9.60 (dBm)

Maximum conducted output power at antenna input terminal: 9.12 (mW)

Antenna gain(typical): 2.90 (dBi)

Maximum antenna gain: 1.95 (numeric)

Prediction distance: 20 (cm)

Prediction frequency: 2440 (MHz)

MPE limit for uncontrolled exposure at prediction frequency: 1 (mW/cm<sup>2</sup>)

Maximum allowable antenna gain: 26.40 (dBi)

Maximum Distance: 1.19 (cm)

**Power density at prediction frequency :** **0.004 (mW/cm<sup>2</sup>)**

*The nominal TX output power level declared by manufacturer is 6 dBm to 9.6 dBm.*

*The MPE was calculated with maximum nominal TX output power 9.6 dBm.*
