# Remote Control User Manual

#### Remote First Time Use Instructions

1) Battery is pre-installed in the remote control. Pull plastic tab from bottom of remote when ready to use. (Note: If the projector does not respond to the remote, please see troubleshooting below)

### Remote Control Battery Replacement

- 1) Open the battery cover on the bottom of the remote by pushing on the tab on the side of the battery tray and pulling the battery tray out from the bottom.
- 2) Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
- 3) Use only type CR2032 or CR2025 3V Lithium battery for replacement, use of other batteries may damage remote.
- 4) Install battery following the polarity shown on the battery compartment.
- 5) Close battery cover by sliding back into place.\_
