



	To take photos.

	Lights up subjects in low-light environments when taking pictures or recording video
3	External Display
	To display notifications and messages.
4	Back Cover
	To protect the internal components of your device.
5	Speaker
	To hear sounds emitted from your phone as well as media content (for example, music and ringtones).

Installing Battery





2. Place the battery, making sure the gold contacts are lined up.

- 3. Push in and press down gently to secure.
- 4. Place the back cover and press it down along the edges to close.

Removing the Battery

 With the phone facing down, insert your fingernail into the cutout located on the bottom of the back cover and gently lift the cover.

Charging the Battery

The battery comes partially charged. You must fully charge the battery before using your device for the first time.

Warning! Use only approved charging devices and batteries. Using other accessories may invalidate your warranty and may cause damage.

Your device comes with a charger (charging head and USB cable) to charge from any electrical outlet.

- 1. Insert the USB cable into the device port.
- Connect the USB cable to the charging head, then plug the charging head into a standard electrical outlet.
- 3. When charging is complete, unplug the charging head from the power outlet and remove the USB cable from the device

Tip to extend and improve your device battery life

Conserve battery power to get the best out of your battery in everyday usage by following settings on select applications:

- · Lower Screen brightness.
- Reduce Backlight time.
- Turn Bluetooth and Wi-Fi off when not in use.
- · Disable GPS when not in use.
- · Enable the battery saver feature.

Replacing the Nano SIM Card

Your device comes with a pre-installed Nano SIM card.

To replace the SIM Card

- 1. Turn off the phone, then remove the back cover and battery.
- Locate the slot for the SIM card and gently slide the SIM card tray down to unlock the tray.
- 3. The SIM is now accessible by opening the tray.

Inserting a MicroSD Card

- Remove the back cover as demonstrated in the previous instructions.
- Position the microSD card with the label side facing up and the gold contacts toward the slot (at the lower-right side of the phone).
- 3. Carefully slide the SD tray to the right to unlock it and place the microSD card in place and lock the tray by sliding left.

NOTE:

- The microSD cards can be damaged easily by improper operation. Be careful when inserting, removing, or handling it.
- The device can support up to a 128GB microSD card.
- To remove the microSD card, follow the similar steps from the Removing the Battery section.

Turning Your Phone ON

Press and hold the **End/Power Key** until the phone powers ON.

The first time you power ON the phone, you will be guided through the following steps:

- Select the phone's language and press the Right Soft Key
 to go to the next step.
- Select and set Accessibility options and press the Right
 Soft Key to go to the next step.
- Select an available Wi-Fi network and press the Right Soft Key to go to the next step.
- Read the KaiOS Terms and Privacy Policy > press the OK
 Key to learn more.
- Use the Navigation Key and the OK Key to set options, then press the Right Soft Key to go to the next step.

- Read and press the Right Soft Key ____ to go to the next step.
- Finally press the **OK Key** to enter the Home screen.

NOTE: Even if no SIM card is installed, your phone will still power on and you will be able to connect to a Wi-Fi network and use some of the phone's features.

Turning Your Phone OFF

Press and hold the **End/Power Key** until the phone displays:

- · Restart and Power OFF.
- Use the Navigation Key to select power OFF > press the OK
 Key

Home Screen

The Home screen serves as the start of your experience.



You can customize your Home screen wallpaper and clock format using the **Settings** app.

From the status bar, you can view both phone status (to the right side) and notification information (to the left side)

Status Bar

The Status Bar appears at the top of every screen. A notification icon appears on the left, and the phone's status icon appears on the right, along with the current time.

Notifications

Notification icons are displayed on the Status Bar displaying calendar events, device status, and much more. The status bar will display the notification icon when you receive a notification.

The Notifications view shows a list of all your recent notifications. You may hear a sound, see a light, or feel the phone vibrate depending on your settings.

To Open the Notification View

From the Home screen > press the **Left Soft Key** to open the Notification view.

A list of all your current notifications appears in the **Notifications** view, organized by ongoing and event-based notifications.

To Respond to a Notification

View the Notifications view, and you will see all your current notifications listed with a brief description.

- Press the **OK Key** to open and view the details of the highlighted notification.
- Press the Left Soft Key to dismiss or delete a highlighted notification.
- Press the Right Soft Key to clear all notifications or access options for a highlighted notification.

Contacts

The Contacts app allows you to store and manage a contact list with names and phone numbers.

From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** > select **Contacts** to enter the contacts list.



Adding a New Contact

- 1. On the Contacts list screen, press the **Left Soft Key** to create a New contact.
- 2. Input the contact information.
- 3. Press the **OK Key** to **SAVE** the contact information.

View a Contact

- On the contacts list screen, use the **Navigation Kev** to select a contact, press the **OK Kev** to access the contact details.
- 2. Press the Left Soft Key to send an SMS/MMS to the selected contact.
- 3. Press the **OK Key** to place a CALL.
- 4. Press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
 - Press Add as Favorite to add a contact as a favorite number.
 - Press Edit to modify a contact detail.
 - Press **Speed Dial** to setup a speed dial contact.
 - Press **Share** to share a contact detail through Bluetooth, Messages, or an E-mail.
 - Press **Delete** to delete a contact detail.
 - Press Find duplicate contacts to search for a duplicate contact information.

Press Block this number to block a number.

Edit a Contact

- On the contacts list screen, using the Navigation Key to select a Contact.
- 2. Press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
- 3. Select Edit and press the **OK Key** to SAVE the edit.

Share a Contact

You can share a single contact information by sending the contact's vCard via Bluetooth, Messages, or E-mail.

- On the contacts list screen, using the Navigation Key to select a Contact.
- 2. Press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
- 3. Select Share to share the single contact information.

Delete a Contact

- On the contacts list screen, using the Navigation Key to select a Contact.
- 2. Press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
- 3. Select Delete to delete the selected contact number.
- 4. Press the Right Soft key to confirm deletion.

Import/Export Contacts

- On the contacts list screen, press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
- Select Settings > Import contacts/Export contacts to import/export contacts from/to memory card, Gmail, or Outlook.

Speed Dial

- On the contacts list screen, press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
- Select Settings > Set Speed Dial Contacts, use the Navigation Key to select 2-9 and press the OK Key to add a contact.
- 3. Press the **OK Key** to confirm.
- 4. On the Home screen, long press the 2-9 screen keys to dial the defined contacts.

Set ICE Contacts

- On the contacts list screen, press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
- Select Settings > Set ICE Contacts to add five contact numbers for setting these numbers as "In case of emergency calls" option.

Create Group

- On the contacts list screen, press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
- 2. Select Settings > Create Group > enter the Group Name.
- 3. Press the **Right Soft Key** to SAVE the group name.
- From the contacts list, press Group > the OK Key > Left Soft Key to add contacts to the group.

Add Account

- On the contacts list screen, press the Right Soft Key to access Options.
- 2. Select Settings > Add Account.
- You can sync contacts, data, or other information can be from multiple accounts, depending on the applications installed on your phone.

Calling

Make phone calls using a variety of calling features and services.

Making a Call

- Dial the desired number and press the CALL key or the **OK** Key to make the call.
- 2. If you make a mistake, you can delete the incorrect digits by pressing the Back/Delete Key .

<<lmage>>

- 3. Press the **Right Soft Key** to display more Options
 - Add to existing contact: Add the entered number to replace the existing contact number.
 - Create new contact: Create a new contact with the entered number.

Make a call from your call log

- From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** > Call Log to access the call log.
- Choose the contact you want to dial, press the CALL Key or the **OK Key** to make the call.

Make a call from Contacts

- From the Home screen, press the Right Soft Key to access Contacts
- Choose the contact you want to dial, press the CALL Key or the **OK Key** to make the call.

Making an emergency call

If your phone has network coverage, dial the emergency number and press the CALL Key to make an emergency call. This option works without a SIM card or typing the PIN code.

Make an International call

To dial an international call, press the "*" key twice to enter "+" in dial screen, enter the international country prefix followed by the complete phone number and press the CALL Key or the **OK Key** to make the call.

Calling your Voicemail

Press and hold 1 key to call and listen to your voicemail.

NOTE: You need to contact your network operator to check for the service availability.

Setting/Checking the Voice mail

Dial *86 and press the **CALL** Key or the **OK Key**. When you hear a greeting, press to interrupt and follow the setup instructions.

NOTE: Voice mailboxes not set up within 45 days will be canceled. Your voice mailbox is not password protected until you create a password by following the setup tutorial. Voice mail may not be available in some areas. Follow the setup instructions to password protect your Verizon voice mailbox. Verizon is not responsible for missed messages or deletions of messages from your voice mailbox, even if you have saved them.

Answering or Rejecting a Call

During an incoming call:

- Open the flip to answer, if Settings > Personalization >
 Answer Mode > Flip open to answer is On. Otherwise, Press the Left Soft Key or Call Key to answer.
- 2. Press the **Right Soft Key** or the End/Power Key to decline.
- Press the **OK Key** to reject the call by sending a preset message.
- 4. To mute the ringtone volume of an incoming call, press the Volume Up/Down Key.

Hang up a Call

During a call:

- 1. Open the flip and press the End/Power Key to end the call.
- 2. Open the flip and close the flip to end the call.

Messages

Use the messaging feature to send and receive text (SMS) and multimedia (MMS) messages.

Sending a Message

- From the Home screen, press the **OK key** > select **Messages**
- 2. Press the **Left Soft Key** to write a New message.
- Enter the phone number of the recipient in the To bar or press the Left Soft Key to add recipients from Contacts.
- 4. Use the **Navigation Key** to go to the SMS bar to enter the text of the message.
- 5. Press the **Left Soft Key** to **Send** the text message.

Sending a Multimedia Message

MMS enables you to send video clips, images, photos, contacts and sounds to other compatible phones and email addresses by pressing the **Right Soft Key** from an open text messages screen and then selecting Add attachment.

An SMS will be converted to MMS automatically when media files (image, video, audio, etc.) are attached or email addresses are added.

NOTE: An SMS of more than 160 characters will be charged as several SMS. Specific letters (accent) will also increase the size of the SMS. This may cause multiple SMS to be sent to your recipient.

Camera

Use the Camera app to take pictures.

From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select **Camera** .



App Permission

The App Permission screen displays upon the first use of Camera, asking for permission to know your location.

Press the **OK Key** to ALLOW or the **Left Soft Key** to Deny.

Take a Picture

- Position the object or landscape in the screen and press the **OK Key** to click a photo.
- 2. Photos are automatically saved to the Gallery app.
- 3. After taking the photo, press the **Left Soft Key** to preview.

700m in/out

Press Up or Down of the **Navigation Key** to zoom lens in and out.

Options

Press the Right Soft Key to access options and the Left and Right Naviation key to select any of the below options:

- Camera Resolution: Select the resolution as High. Standard. or Low.
- Self Timer: Sets the time a photo is taken after pressing the OK Kev.
- Grid: Adds grid lines to photo screen to help take better photos by using grid lines to align photo image.
- Gallery: Select Go to Gallery Application to view photos previously taken.

Modes: Select to switch between Photo and Video mode.

Record a Video

- Press Left and Right of the Navigation Key to switch between Photo and Video mode.
- Press Up or Down of the **Navigation Key** to zoom lens in and out.
- 3. Press the **OK Key** to record a video, press again to stop recording. Videos will be automatically saved to Video app.

Tools

Music

Use the music player to listen to your favorite tracks.

The USB cable that is shipped with your phone can be used to transfer music files or to download music directly to your phone.

To access Music, from the Home screen, press the **OK Kev** and select Music III.

Video

Video acts as a media player for you to view videos.

1. From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** > select Video



- 2. Press the Left Soft Key to enter Camera to take a video.
- 3. Use the **Navigation Key** to select a video, press the **OK Key** to play the video.
- 4. Press the **Right Soft Key** to access Options:
 - Flash
 - Video Resolution
 - Go to Video
 - Modes

Clock

From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select Clock ...



Alarm

From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select **Clock** > Alarm

- 2. Press the **Left Soft Key** to add a **New** alarm. The following options will appear:
 - **Time** Select to set the alarm time.
 - Repeat Select the days you want your alarm to go off.
 - Sound Select a ringtone for the alarm.
 - Vibrate Select to activate vibration.
 - Alarm Name Press to enter a name for the alarm.
- 3. Press the **Right Soft Key** to **Save**.

Timer

- From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select **Clock** Timer.
- Press the **OK Key** and then Left or Right of the **Navigation Key** to edit Hour, Minute, and Second.
- 3. Press the **OK Key** to START the timer.
 - When the Timer is ongoing, press the **OK Key** to **PAUSE** and **RESUME** to continue the timer.
 - Press the **Right Soft Key** to add 1 minute.
 - When the timer is paused, press the Left Soft Key to Reset the timer.
- Once the timer is reset, press the Right Soft Key to select Settings such as:
 - Snooze
 - System Alarm Volume
 - Vibrate
 - Sound

Stopwatch

- From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select **Clock** > Stopwatch.
- 2. Press the **OK Key** to START the Stopwatch.
 - When the Stopwatch is ongoing, press the **Right Soft Key** to record the Lap.
 - Press the **OK Key** to PAUSE the stopwatch.
 - When the Stopwatch is paused, press the **OK Key** to RESUME the stopwatch.
 - Press the **Left Soft Key** to Reset the stopwatch and clear lap times.

Note

From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select **Note** 1.



- 1. Press the **Left Soft Key** to add New note > enter the contents > press the **Right Soft Key** to **Save**.
- 2. On the notes list, press the **Right Soft Kev** to access Options such as:
 - Delete
 - Share
 - Select multiple
 - Search
 - Sort by
- 3. Use the **Navigation Key** to select the note.
- 4. Press the **OK Key** to view the details.
- 5. Press the **OK Key** to edit and **Right Soft Key** to Save the edit.

File Manager

From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select **File Manager**

File Manager displays all data stored on the phone and the MicroSD card, including applications, media files downloaded from Store, YouTube or other locations; videos, pictures or audios you have captured; other data transferred via Bluetooth, USB cable, etc.

When you download an application from PC to phone/microSD card, you can locate the application using File Manager, then touch it to install it in your phone.

File Manager allows you to perform and be really efficient with the following common operations: create (sub) folder, open folder/file, view, rename, move, copy, delete, play, share, and much more.

Calendar

Use the Calendar to keep track of important meetings, appointments, etc.

View Calendar

- From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select Calendar
- Press the **OK Key** to view the CALENDAR. You can display the Calendar in Day, Week, Month view.
- 3. Press the **Right Soft Key** to select Options such as:
 - Week view
 - Day view
 - Go to date
 - Search
 - Calendar to display

Settings

Create New Event

- Press the Left Soft Key to Add new events from any Calendar view.
- 2. Fill in all required information for this new event.
- If it is a wholeday event you can press the **OK Key** to select **All-day event**.
- 4. Press the **Right Soft Key** to **Save**.

Delete and Edit Event

After creating a new event, under Month view or Day view, use the **Navigation Key** to move to the event.

Press the **OK Key** to show events list > press the **Left Soft Key** to delete or press the **Right Soft Key** to edit.

Event reminder

If a reminder is set for an event, the upcoming event will appear on the Status bar as a notification when the reminder time arrives.

Calculator

- From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select Calculator
 - 0-9: Input numbers
 - *: Decimal(.)
 - #: +/-
 - Right Soft key: Clear All
 - Left Soft key: Clear

ToDo

- From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select ToDo
- 2. Press the Left Soft Key to add a New task list.
- Fnter the List Name.
- 4. Press the Right Soft Key to Create.
- 5. Press the **Right Soft Key** to access Options such as:
 - Edit
 - Delete
 - Delete all

Recorder

- From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select Recorder
- 2. Press the **Left Soft Key** to create a New recording.
- Press the **OK Key** to start recording and press the **Right Soft Key** to Done.
- 4. Use the **Navigation Key** to select the recording you want to play back.
- 5. Press the **OK Key** twice to play.
- 6. Press the **Right Soft Key** to access Options such as:
 - Delete
 - Share
 - Select multiple
 - Rename
 - Save as ringtone

- Save to music library
- Settings

Gallery

The Gallery app provides you with one location to view and organize all your saved photos.

- From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select Gallery
- 2. Press the **Left Soft Key** to switch Favorites and Gallery list.
- Use the Navigation Key to select an image and press the OK Key to open and view the image.
- 4. Press the Right Soft Key to access the Options such as:
 - · Delete: Delete the selected photo.
 - Edit: Select this option to adjust exposure value, rotate the photo, crop, add filters and auto-correction.
 - Add to favorites/Remove from favorites: Add/Remove the selected photo to/from the Favorites list.
 - Share: Share the photo via Email, Messages and Bluetooth, etc.
 - Select multiple: Allows you to select more than one photo in the Gallery.
 - File info: Displays file name, size, image type, date taken, resolution, and path.
 - Sort and group: Sorts photo by date and time or groups by date.

E-Mail

Setup E-Mail

From the Home screen, press the **OK Key** and select E-Mail



An email wizard will guide you through the steps to set up an email account, press the Right Soft Key to continue.

- Enter the name and email for the account you want to setup. 1.
- 2. Press the **Right Soft Key** to access Next, enter password of the account and press the Right Soft Key . If the account you entered is not provided by your service provider in the phone, you will be prompted to manually setup your email.
- 3. To add another email account, you can press the **Right Soft Kev** to access Options > Settings > Add.

Send E-Mail

- 1. Press the **Left Soft Key** to compose a new email from the Inbox screen.
- 2. Enter recipient(s) email address(es) in the To field, press the **OK Key** to confirm and add new recipient(s).
- 3. Type the subject and the content of the message. You may use your voice to enter the subject and content of your emails by pressing and holding the **OK Key** button.
- 4. Press the **Right Soft Kev** to Add cc/bcc or Add attachment to the message.
- 5. If you do not want to send the mail right away, you can press the **Right Soft Key** and select Save as draft to save a copy.
- 6. Press the Left Soft Kev to Send.

Network & Connectivity

Airplane mode

When Airplane mode is on, all wireless connections are disabled simultaneously, including Wi-Fi and Bluetooth.

- 1. Press the **OK Key** to enter Airplane mode.
- Press the Navigation Key to select ON or OFF, then press the OK Key to confirm.

Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi will allow you to surf the internet without using your device network when in range of a wireless network.

- 1. Press the **OK Key** to enter Wi-Fi.
- 2. Press the Navigation Key to select ON/OFF.
- 3. Press the **OK Key** to turn ON the Wi-Fi.
- 4. Press the Up and Down of the Navigation Key to select Available networks, then press the OK Key to enter all available networks list, select one and press the OK Key to configure the access point and connect your phone.

NOTE: You may need to enter a password if applicable.

Press the Up and Down of the Navigation Key to select Advanced settings, then press the OK Key to set more options.

Bluetooth

Bluetooth allows your phone to exchange data (videos, images, music, etc.) with other Bluetooth devices within a close range such as another phone, computer, printer, headset, car kit, and so on.

- 1. Press the **OK Key** to enter Bluetooth.
- Press the Navigation Key to select ON, then press the OK Key to turn on Bluetooth.
 - Visible to all Press the OK Key to enter, and select ON to view list of visible devices
 - My phone's name Press the OK Key to enter, edit the name then press the Right Soft Key to Save.
