



1. Installing & removing battery

7 • Battery cover is waterproof design, with two water-proof screws; open & close battery cover by using coins or other instruments, then rotate anti-clock · Remove battery. Pull up the battery from the bottom slot, then take out the battery Install battery. Match the battery copper part to the phone battery connector and insert the battery.

• When close back cover, rotate 8 or 9 circles in clockwise by using coins or other common instrument, it would be completely tightened



Push battery back into the battery compartment, then install the battery cover and tighten the battery cover screw.

The following rules prolong battery life time effectively

· New battery or long-term unused batteries require longer time to charge Keep battery temperature near room temperature when charging · After long-term use, the battery will gradually wear and require longer time to charge, which is a normal phenomenon. However, if the normal talking

time is reduced after normal charging, or the charging time increases, you need to buy the original battery or Outfone authorized battery; Inferior accessories may damage your phone and may be dangerous! After a long time lay aside or battery with low volume, it will take some time to show charging screen , please wait patiently

Please be careful of the environment, do not threw the battery everywhere!

🚺 Any form of battery short-circuit may cause explosion, fire or personal injury or other serious consequences!

Where phone charging (data) port operation involved, please reset the rubber plug well to ensure the waterproof performance

· Open the phone's USB rubber plug, see right picture Insert the data cable to the USB port and begin charging

Connect the charger improperly may cause serious damage to the device. Any damage caused by improper using are not covered under warranty

• It can be charged either power on or off. The screen will show charging image when charging. · After fully charged, please disconnect the charger and data cable. Reset rubber plug well to ensure waterproof and dustproof performance

Do not remove battery before disconnecting the charger, it may damage to the device

♠ Do not use a damaged power cord or poor socket ; Do not touch the power cord with wet hands or pull cord to disconnect the charger to avoid

3. Insert SIM. T-Flash card

• S15 is a three-slot vertical overlay setting, from top to bottom, there be SIM1, SIM2 and T-Flash card slot

S15 supports Micro/Nano SIM card and other non-standard SIM card; for non-standard card, as long as put Micro /Nano SIM card into our random card sets (as per picture), then insert into the slot; standard SIM card not need card sets, can be directly inserted into the card slot.

• Do not bend or scratch your SIM card, do not let it touch static electricity, dust or water: If the SIM card is lost, please immediately contact your network operator for assistance[Note] Card sets on for Micro / Nano SIM cards and other non-standard card; Standard SIM

I-Flash memory card may be supplied together with the device or may alread e inserted in device. Open the battery cover after removing the battery, T- fla: card can be inserted directly into the card slot

4. Basic keys

(1) Power on/off: long press power button for seconds to power on or off

(2) Screen on/off; press power on/off button to show screen or sleep mode

(3) Close ringtone: when there be incoming call, press the power button to close the ringing tone

PTT button: When using the walkie talkie, hold this key for talk

. Volume button: you can control call, music, video volume · Customized button: the special function which is customized

• Home Button: Press the HOME key to return to the main screen. If you want to quickly enter the main interface, you can press the HOME key at any interface status







5. NFC

The device support NFC. Operation way:

1. Enter Setting-More-NFC and choose NFC ON.

II. Walkie talkie instruction

Before you use walkie talkie, you need install the walkie talkie antenna. Otherwise you may break the phone

1. Work frequency

• The walkie talkie module has been built in the phone that works at 400-470 MHz. User can set up your walkie talkie work frequency according to your country's law

· Communication distance: 3-5 KM in the open space (Using original antenna)

2. Install walkie talkie antenna

 Install the walkie talkie antenna and reach the longest communication distance • Open the walkie talkie antenna port, ,rotate the antenna into the port and tight it up(see right picture)。

. Walkie talkie basic information and related settings

Only terminals with same frequency and CTCSS can communicate

The walkie talkie is always in receiving statue after you release the PTT key

· In walkie talkie interface, press volume key to adjust the volume

of the phone screen. You can use walkie talkie even without entering walkie talkie interface

the walkie talkie. Or you can press OPTION key in walkie talkie interface and click quit walkie talkie

4. Instruction to walkie talkie

Keep the phone screen right to your face

speak and wait for reply from other side.

Enter the walkie talkie interface from main menu, click SET VALUA and set the walkie talkie parameter

• Set channel interval(GBW). The GBW is different in different countries, normally you can choose from two value 12.5 KHz and 25 Khz

• Set to default means you save the current settings. You can use this setting next time you enter the walkie talkie interface

· Set power. In setting mode, you can choose high or low transmitting power. High transmitting power make it maximum communication distance, but

• Set SQ. Normal SQ value is from 1 to 8.1 means highest SQ but with maximum noise. 8 is lowest SQ but with minimum noise. You can set according

• Set CTCSS. It is a simple way of encryption to isolate other same frequency uses. If the frequency you select is used by others, you can set CTCSS

• Press PTT key and send voice to walkie talkie microphone. Keep the microphone is 2.5cm to 5cm away from your mouth. Release the PTT key after

• In walkie talkie interface, press HOME key, the walkie talkie will be running in background. In background statue, there will be an icon in tool bar upside

o quit the walkie talkie, you need enter the walkie talkie interface and press BACK key. It will show notice that whether to quit or not. Press Yes to quit

· Set working frequency. In setting mode, input the frequency you need and click save to finish setting of transmitting and receiving frequency, high or low power, SQ, CTCSS andchannel interval. Normally set the transmitting and receiving frequency same frequency
