




Long pressing any widgets; you can create a shortcut on the desktop


Click **Settings** icon, then select wireless & network:



● Wi-Fi settings


Turn on Wi-Fi **ON**. Device can search for nearby Wi-Fi network automatically and display related network information. Choose the WIFI router.

If it displays locked as , you need type password to connect:




