in general – even when the 2 part statement is allowed in the users manual the device itself should still be labeled with the FCC ID. We have seen very few cases that the FCC has not required the ID still on the device itself, which is usually only when the device is the size of a pill. To continue and accept, we will have to get approval from the FCC to allow the proposed label cited, or alternatively the applicant or lab may ask permission. Kindly let us know how you wish to proceed. Communication that takes more than one simple round with the FCC may require additional charges. Kindly note that to proceed, final manuals would be required for various comments below.
