
Phone Quick Start Guide

#### Messaging & Email

#### Email setup

(BC)

1. From the Home screen > Google 🚼 > Gmail (M).



- 2. Select Got It > Add an email address, then select an email provider.
- 3. Enter your account credentials, such as email address and password. Tap **NEXT** to continue.
- 4. Confirm email account settings, tap **NEXT**.
- 5. Enter your name which will be displayed on outgoing emails, tap NEXT.

#### Text and Picture Messaging

- 1. From the **Home screen > Messages =** .
- 2. Tap to begin a new message.
- 3. In the **To** field, enter a number or a contact name, or tap Favorites or All Contacts to select a contact from the address book.
- 4. Tap "Text Message" field and enter your text.
- 5. Touch (+) to send smileys & emotions, give access to Location, select of to send photos. videos, contact information, files, or sound recordings.
- 6. Tap > to send the message.

#### **Quick Settings**

- 1. From the Home screen, drag your finger down to view the Notifications panel.
- 2. With the **Notifications panel** open, drag your finger down again to open the Quick Settings menu.
- 3. Tap **Settings** on the bottom middle to access the full Settings menu.

#### Secure Your Phone

- 1. From **Settings** (1) menu, tap **Security** & biometrics.
- 2. Enable your lock/unlock method: Swipe, Pattern, PIN, Password, or Face Unlock.\*
- 3. Face Unlock will unlock your phone using the front camera to register your face.

\* Facial Recognition methods may not be as secure as Pattern, Pin, or Password locks.

#### **Capture Life's Moments**

#### Take a Picture or Record a Video

- 1. From the **Home screen > Camera** (a).
  - To take a photo: Tap or press the Volume up/down key to take a photo.
  - To take a video: From Camera > Video > **Record** • to start recording. Tap • to stop recording.

#### Camera features and settings

- 1. To select a different camera mode, tap an option above (a):
  - · Video: Shoot and record videos.
  - · Auto: The default camera mode will automatically adjust the focus, lighting, and
  - · Portrait: Create a depth of field effect.
  - · Pano: Capture a horizontally elongated field of view.
- 2. At the top of the camera screen, you can access camera settings image and video size , High-Dynamic-Range HDR, enable a timer , apply a real-time filter , or enable flash 74

### How to replace the SIM

#### Install a SIM/microSD<sup>™</sup> Card

1. With the phone face down, remove back cover by gently pulling up on the indentation on the bottom left of the cover.



2. Insert the SIM card and microSD™ card\* with gold contacts facing down.



3. Ensure that SIM and microSD™ cards have been

#### Make a Call

- 1. From the **Home screen >**
- 2. Tap **Dialer** to access the keypad, or select one of the following:
- Choose frequently called or favorite contacts in Favorites \* .
- · Choose recently called numbers and contacts in Recents O.
- Choose a saved contact in Contacts
- 3. Tap \(\mathbb{\ceil}\) to place the call.

## Surf & Stream in no time

#### Connect to Wi-Fi

- 1. From the **Home screen**. swipe down once.
- 2. Press and hold Wi-Fi 🛜 to open the Wi-Fi menu.
- 3. Tap to turn on Wi-Fi.
- 4. Tap a network name. Enter a password, if required, then tap **CONNEECT**.

#### Use Bluetooth

- 1. From the **Home screen**, swipe down once.
- 2. Press and hold **Bluetooth** > to open the Connected Devices menu.



- 3. Tap Pair new device to turn Bluetooth on and display a list of available devices.
- 4. Tap the name of the device to initiate pairing.

Your phone is equipped with Real-Time Text (RTT) settings. To enable, swipe up to go to Apps > Settings Accessibility > Call accessibility > RTT Call Button > RTT operation mode.
