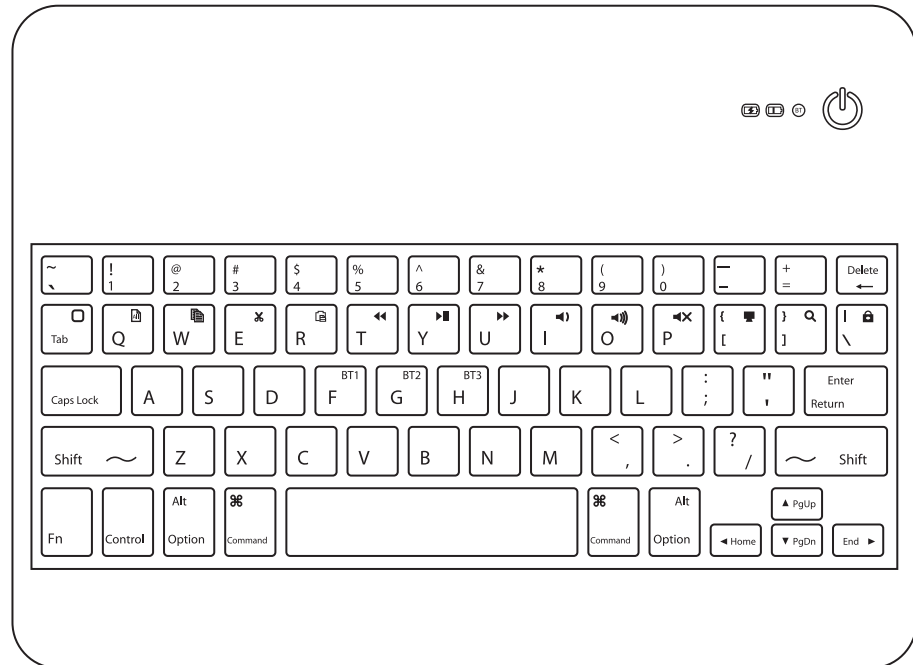


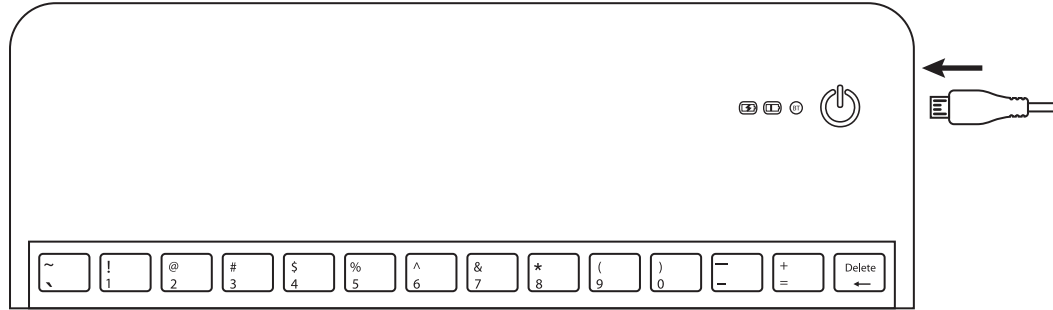

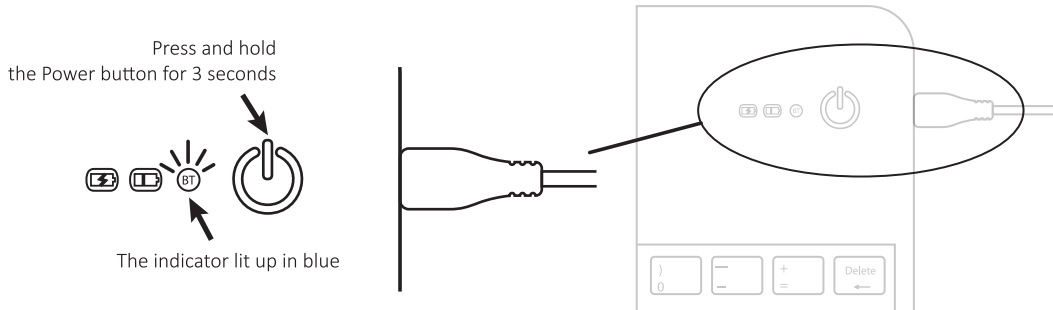
Charging Bt Keyboard

Charge the Bt Keyboard with the Micro USB charging cable as shown.

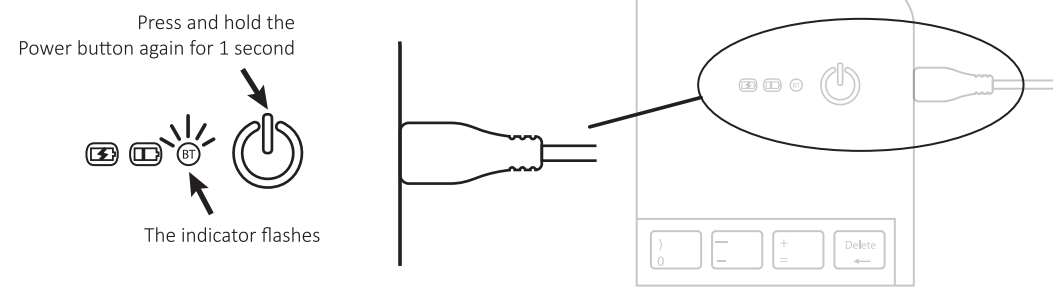


Pairing the Bt Keyboard

Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds until the indicator lit up in blue.



Press and hold the power button again for 1 second until indicator flashes, the Bt keyboard is now ready to pair.

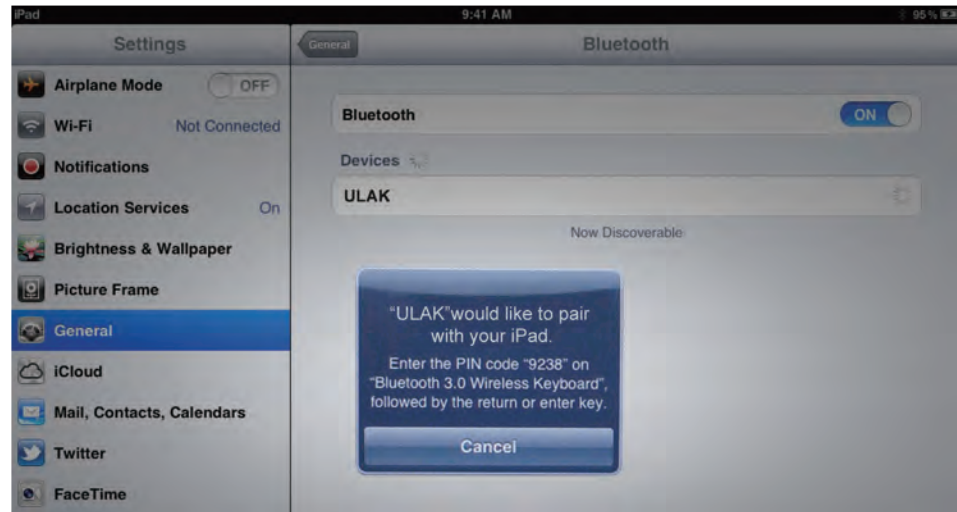


Setup Bt Keyboard

Enter the Bt setup menu on your iPad, iPhone.



Search for available devices, select "ULAK".

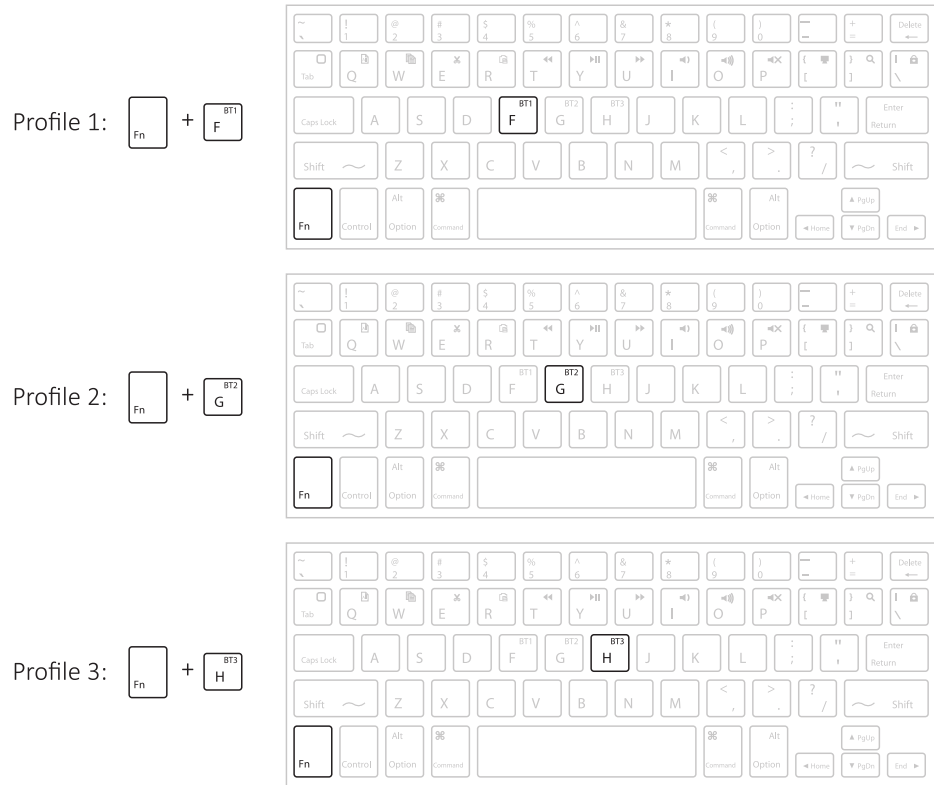


A 4 digit password would prompt, enter the 4 digit password using the Bt Keyboard.

The indicator will stop flashing showing pairing is successful and the Bt Keyboard is ready to use.

Switching & Pairing Multiple Devices **

The Bt Keyboard supports pairing up to 3 devices, switch between profile by using the following short cut:



The Bt Keyboard comes default in profile 1, please follow the "Pairing the Bt Bluetooth Keyboard" procedures.

Switch to Profile 2 by pressing **Fn + G**, follow the "Pairing the Bt Keyboard" procedures to pair with the second device.

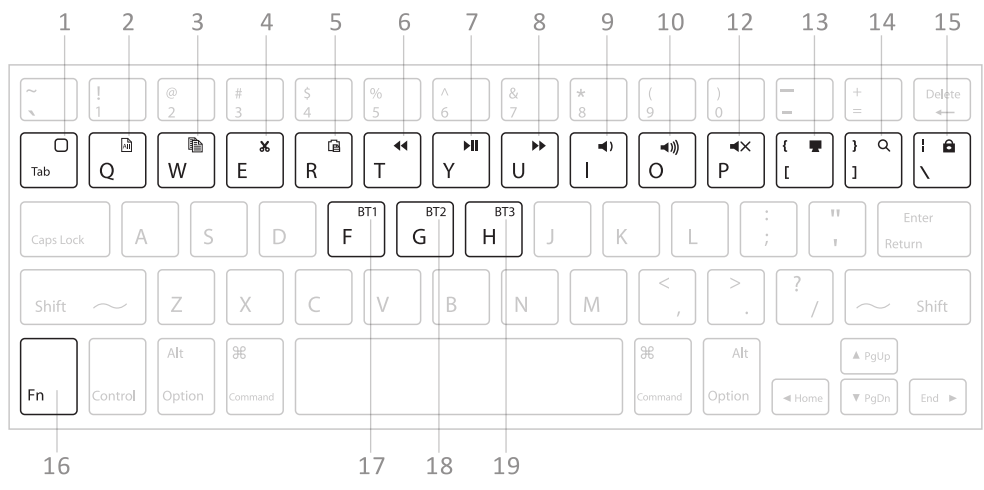
Switch to Profile 3 by pressing **Fn + H**, follow the "Pairing the Bt Keyboard" procedures to pair with the third device.

** Please allow 3 seconds for profile changes.

Cautions

Don't expose the keyboard in liquid or humidity environment.
Use special PU cleaning fluid to clean the case.
Don't expose the keyboard under ultra high temperature or low temperature environment.
Don't expose the keyboard under the sun for long period of time.
Don't expose the keyboard near fire, candle or fireplace.
Don't use sharp objects to cut the keyboard case.
NOTE: Please charge the battery for 10 hours fully for first time of use.
And fully use the battery after first time of use.
Please charge the battery every month if you don't use the keyboard for a very long time in order to extend the BT keyboard life expectancy.
