



# RC STUNT CAR



#### **INSTALLING BATTERIES IN THE TRANSMITTER:**

- 1 Open the battery compartment.
- 2 Insert 2 x 1.5V AA batteries with correct + and polarities.
- 3 Close the cover.






#### LITHIUM BATTERY CHARGE INSTRUCTIONS:


Attention: Do not charge battery immediately after each play, let the battery cool down for a while. Turn off the vehicle switch before charging.


- 1. Turn off vehicle and open the battery compartment.
- 2. Plug the large end of USB cable into a 5Vd.c. 2A charger (not supplied) or USB port only.
- 3. The vehicle indicator light will light up and will be solid when charging. When it finishes charging, the vehicle indicator light extinguishes.



#### **HOW TO USE:**

- 1. Turn on the vehicle first and then turn on the transmitter.
- 2. Pull the trigger of the transmitter to match the vehicle.
- 3. When the vehicle is functioning, that means they are matched.
- 4. If you have more than two vehicles, please pair one by one. When the second vehicle is pairing, please always keep the first vehicle and transmitter on.
- 5. Please turn off both the vehicle and transmitter and re-start all pairing processes if you are changing to play with another 2.4GHz transmitter.
- 6. How to move forwards or backwards: Pull the throttle trigger, the vehicle will move forwards.
- Push the throttle trigger, the vehicle will move backwards.
- 7. Turn left or right: Turn steering wheel clockwise, the vehicle will turn right. Turn steering wheel anticlockwise, the vehicle will turn left.









#### **HOW TO FLIP OVER:**

Push or pull the throttle trigger, when the vehicle hits an obstacle at high speed, the vehicle will flip over. Pull the throttle trigger, when the vehicle runs in high speed, then quickly push the throttle trigger for the
