ONE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Moov Inc. ("Moov") warrants the Moov hardware product (the "Product"), and only the Product, against defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for a period of ONE YEAR (365 days) from the date of retail purchase by the original purchaser ("Warranty Period"). Under this Limited Warranty, if a hardware defect arises and a valid claim is received by Moov within the Warranty Period, at its option and to the extent permitted by law, Moov will either (1) repair the Product at no charge, using new or refurbished replacement parts or (2) exchange the Product with a new or refurbished Product. If Moov Inc. determines it is not reasonable to replace the defective Product, Moov may refund you the purchased price paid for the Product. In the event of a defect or issue, to the extent permitted by law, which can vary from state to state, these are your sole and exclusive remedies.

A replacement Product or part assumes the remaining warranty of the original Product or ninety (90) days from the date of replacement, whichever is longer.

When a Product or part of the Product is exchanged, any replacement item becomes your property and the replaced item becomes Moov's property.
