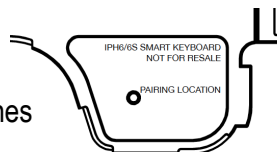


Using your KéNero

- ✓ On rear of Thunderbird locate the pairing push button as marked
- ✓ On iPhone go “Settings” set “Bluetooth On”
- ✓ Depress pairing button – Front Blue Light Flashes
- ✓ Select Thunderbird in “Other Device” set “Pair” see “Connected”
- ✓ Go to Notes app & check typing input



KéNero Features

Protective Case Fitting.

The Thunderbird will snap fit to the Front & Rear of the included protective case.
 The case offers a rail system to easily slide the Keyboard on the front of the iPhone.
 The back rail system offers a Thunderbird storage location when not in use.

Screen Protection.

A glass screen protector is included to be fitted to the iPhone using the Thunderbird.
 If you already have a screen protector fitted then keep the provided one as a spare.
 If fitting the supplied screen protector then follow the fitting instructions.

Function Fn Key.

Single depression of Fn key sets next character to a symbol then reverts back to normal input.
 Fast double depression of the Fn key sets and locks input to numerical and symbol only.
 A fast double depression sets the Fn lock OFF mode.

Shift Key.

Single depression of Shift key sets next input to capitalise then reverts to normal input.
 Fast double depression of the Shift key sets and locks character input to all capitalise input.
 A fast double depression sets the Shift lock OFF.

Power and Charging.

The Thunderbird contains a rechargeable battery and a USB charging cable.
 Charge the Thunderbird using any USB charging port.
 On connecting to a USB port a Red light will be on at the most Selfie left key.
 Full charge takes around 45 mins with the Red light going off when finished.
 When connected a % battery status in iPhone Notifications is shown (~ 10 seconds).
 Low battery at ~ 20% the Blue light will momentarily flash when using.

Quick Tips.

Your iPhone unlock P/W – If a numeric p/w, set Function Lock to ON and start with a RETURN key.
 The keyboard layout is optimised for US QWERTY layout – Use US English Keyboard on iPhone
 Thunderbird snaps on and slides up and down the front of the iPhone supplied case.
 The keyboard can act as a remote Selfie Shutter in Camera and Video Mode (up to 10 meters).
 Thunderbird wake-up is by depression of any key.
 Fitting the Thunderbird onto the rear lower position of the case will instantly sleep Thunderbird.
 Removing the Thunderbird from the case rear will wake Thunderbird and connect to iPhone.
 If asleep for inactivity, fitted to the rear of case - any key is needed to wake up on removal.
 If backlight is on an independent 20 second off timer takes place for no keyboard activity.

KéNero Smart Commands

Note: The Smart Commands are dependant on the application running
 The backlight has a 20 second sleep timer for no keyboard activity
 The Thunderbird will sleep after 50 seconds of no keyboard activity

Capitalised a Character - Hold the required key down for a short duration to input uppercase

SPACE + SPACE Double space adds a period with capitalisation to end a sentence



CMD + SPACE Toggle keyboard languages or Emoji choice as in the iPhone keyboard set up

CMD + Fn Key (Right) (one click) Go to iPhone HOME screen
 CMD + Fn Key (Right) (two click) Go to iPhone apps screen
 CMD + Fn Key (Right) (hold duration) Open Siri (Another click of CMD + Fn Right "Siri Off")
 CMD + Fn Key (Left) Blank and Lock screen
 CMD + Shift Key (Right) iPhone screen brightness up
 CMD + Shift Key (Left) iPhone screen brightness down

CMD + A Select All
 CMD + C Copy highlighted text
 CMD + V Paste copied text
 CMD + Z Undo last action
 CMD + M Hide / Show New Email – Email App

CMD + B Set Bold text On/Off
 CMD + I Set Italic text On/Off
 CMD + U Set Underline text On/Off

CMD + D (hold duration) Send Email
 CMD + A (hold duration) Attach File to Email
 CMD + N New Note, New Email
 CMD + R Reply to Email
 CMD + R (hold duration) Reply to All Email
 CMD + F (hold duration) Forward Email

CMD + DEL Delete all text to beginning of line
 Fn +  Turn Backlight On / Off
 Hide or Show iPhone virtual keyboard
 Shift + \$ Input UK £ currency symbol

Shutter Key Shutter Key when in Camera App or Video Start /Stop
 Ringer Up – In Home Screen
 Volume Up – In Music/Video App

Shift + Shutter Key Ringer Down – In Home Screen
 Volume Down – In Music/Video App
