



## Bluetooth Headset

Operation Manual: FB-32-AST2

Thank you for choosing the FB-32-AST2 headset. In order to better understand various functions of your headset, please read this manual carefully and keep it for your reference.

### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Do not place the product in extremely high or low temperature environments.

Keep out of direct sunlight for long periods of time. These factors will affect battery performance and life.

This product is not waterproof.

Do not place the product in water or submerge.

Do not puncture or harm the exterior surface of the product in any way.

Do not use this unit for anything other than its intended use or purpose. Doing so may damage the device.

This product is not a toy. Keep out of reach of children.

Do not use the unit at excessive levels as this may damage hearing.

### CHARGING THE HEADSET

The headset has a built-in rechargeable battery. The battery is fully pre-charged before its first use. Please use the charging cable included with your headset to charge it.

**WARNING:** Do not charge using an unspecified charger. Non-specified chargers may damage your headset. Do not use the headset while it is charging.

### PAIRING THE HEADSET

1. With the headset off, press and hold the multifunction button for 6 seconds until the blue and red LED light flashes. This will indicate your headset is now in pairing mode.
2. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.
3. Your device will start searching for wireless devices.
4. The headset will appear as "FB-32-AST2" in the list of available Bluetooth devices.
5. Select "FB-32-AST2"
6. Enter password "0000" if prompted, to complete pairing your headset to your device.

**NOTE:** If pairing is unsuccessful, turn off headset and re-pair following above steps. Once you have paired the headset, your headset will automatically connect to your device the next time it is in range.

### DIALING THROUGH YOUR PHONE

1. Select the relevant contact from your list of contacts on your device.
2. Press the call button on your phone and call.

### ANSWERING A CALL

1. When an incoming call comes in, press the multifunction key to answer to call.
2. You can also answer the call through your phone. When you answer through your phone, you may need to press and hold the multifunction button on your headset for 2 seconds after you answer to switch the incoming call from your phone to your headset. This depends on the model of your phone.

### ENDING A CALL

1. During a call, press the multifunction key to end call.
2. You can also end your call through your phone.

### REDIAL

Click the multifunction button twice to redial the last number dialed.  
This function varies by phone model.

### REJECT A CALL

1. When an incoming call comes in, press and hold

the multifunction button for 2 seconds to reject a call.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

If the headset fails to charge, check whether the charging cable is connected properly.  
If the headset fails to turn on, check to see whether the battery has been depleted and needs to be recharged.
