
Pairing the Speaker

- 1. Turn the Speaker ON by switching the [POWER] switch to the ON position. A tone will be heard indicating that the speaker has power and the LED panel (front) will turn on, reading "bLUE."
- 2. Set your Bluetooth-enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices. When the Bluetooth-enabled device finds the speaker, select "SBT2012" from the list of found devices.
- 3. After a successful pairing, several tones will be heard.



On an iOS or Android Device

• Go to **SETTINGS** > **BLUETOOTH** (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)

Installing the Remote Battery


- 1. To install/remove the remote battery, pinch the side of the battery pack and slide it out of the remote.
- 2. Remove the old CR2025 battery and/or place a new one inside the battery pack, contact (negative end) facing down.
- 3. Slide the battery pack back in so that it clicks and locks into place.



Mounting the Speaker

The speaker can be placed on long, narrow spaces or it can be mounted on a wall with the two mounting screws. The speaker is 37 inches long.

1. Drill two guide holes into the area on a wall you would like to hang your speaker. These holes should be 26.25 inches apart and will be used for anchors, so they are just smaller than the anchors themselves.



2. Push or gently hammer an anchor into each guide hole so that they are secure and won't move.

3. Screw or drill the two mounting screws into the anchors, and hang the speaker on the two screws by inserting the screws into the mounting holes on the speaker and gently sliding down to secure.

NOTE: The speaker should not move in any direction while mounted.






Connecting the Speaker

Connecting via Optical Audio Cable

Attach the optical audio cable (not included) to the optical audio port on the input panel of the speaker. Attach the other end to the optical audio output port to your media device. Press the [M] button on the control panel or remote control to switch to the OP input, the LED panel will read "-OP-."

Connecting via RCA Cable

Attach the white end of the supplied RCA cable to the left RCA port on the input panel of the speaker and attach the red end of the cable to the right RCA port. Attach the other end to the audio output on your media device. Press the [M] button on the control panel or remote control to switch to the AUX 1 input, the LED panel will read "AUX 1."



Connecting via 3.5mm Auxiliary Cable

Attach the 3.5mm auxiliary cable to the AUX-in jack on the input panel of the speaker. Attach the other end to the 3.5mm or headphone jack of your media device. Press the [M] button on the control panel or remote control to switch to the AUX 2 input, the LED panel will read "AUX 2."

Using the Speaker

Powering ON/OFF

- To turn the speaker ON, flip the [POWER] switch on the input panel to the ON position.
- To turn the speaker OFF, flip the [POWER] switch on the approved could void the user's authority to operate the input panel to the OFF position.
- To put the speaker into standby mode, press the [@] button on the remote.

Volume Adjustment

- To increase the volume, long press the [⋈/v+] button on the input panel or the [+] button on the remote. The volume will gradually rise and the LED panel will display the volume level.
- To decrease the volume, long press the [⋈/٧-] button on the input panel or the [—] button on the remote. The volume will gradually lower and the LED panel will display the volume level.
- Press the [□□×] button on the remote to mute the

Switching Modes

• To change between Bluetooth, AUX 1, and AUX 2 modes, quick press the [M] button on the control panel or the [M] button on the remote control. The current mode will be displayed on the LED panel.

Playing Music

To enjoy music wirelessly on your speaker, make sure you are paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device. Once paired, you can control the media playback and volume adjustment with the controls on your paired device or use the controls on the control panel on the speaker or

Playing/Pausing Music

- To pause media playback, press the [⋈]] button on the speaker's control panel or remote.
- To resume media playback, press the [□1] button again, on the speaker's control panel or remote.

Skipping Tracks

- To skip to the next track, quick press the [⋈/٧+] button on the speaker's control panel or press the [▷↘] button on the remote.
- To skip to a previous track, quick press the [⋈/v-] button on the speaker's control panel or press the [⋈] button on the remote.
