
Including speaker*1, glass*1, foot*2, hex screws*6, washer*6, lock washer*6, screwdriver*1 and remote control*1.




The assemble



Note: Your power cord may look different from the one pictured here.

to HDMI IN1 or HDMI IN2 interface, by using an HDMI cable, connecting the TV or some other devices to the HDMI out interface.

Note: We suggest connecting with HDMI ARC interface of TV.

- Connect one end of the digital COA cable to the unit, the other end to an external device




- Connect one end of the Aux-in link cable to AUX IN jack on the front of the unit, the other end to an external device.

- Connect one end of the digital OPT cable to the unit, the other end to an external device












ECO Mode (Power Saving Mode)

The screen will turn off automatically and enter power-saving mode
If no operation is performed for 3 minutes during playing, click
operation panel or any button of remote control to reactivate .

Standby Mode

The sound system will automatically turn off and go into standby mode
if no sound input within 15 minutes, click the operation panel or any key
of the remote control to reactivate.

Adjust volume level



press  /  to increase/decrease the volume level.

press BASS to increase/decrease
the subwoofer volume level.

press Treble to increase/decrease
the tweeter volume level.

press RESET to Reset the subwoofer volume level
and the tweeter volume level.

Troubleshooting

No sound

- Make sure the sound system is turned on and the power indicator is on .
- Make sure the sound system is not muted.
- Increase the volume.
- Make sure the audio cable connection is correct and secure on the sound system and the TV.
- Make sure the TV of your play devices is on and set to the correct input.
- If you are using a digital audio connection, check that the TV's digital audio output is enabled. See your TV owner's guide for information.
- If a digital audio connection is not possible, use an analog stereo audio connection.
- If the sound system is connected to a TV output labelled VARIABLE (VAR), make sure the TV's internal speakers are turned off, the TV volume is turned up, and the TV is not muted.

Remote control is inconsistent or does not work

- Check the battery to be sure it is installed properly or if it needs to be replaced.
- Point the remote control at the sound system when you press a button.
- Check that the power indicator on the sound system flashes when you press the remote volume or mute button.

Sound is distorted

- Make sure cable connections are secure on the sound system and TV.
- If the sound system is connected to a TV output labelled VARIABLE (VAR), reduce the TV volume.

Sound is coming from the TV

- Turn off your TV's internal speakers.
- Turn the TV volume all the way down.

Bluetooth®

A device cannot connect with the Surround Base.

- The device does not support the compatible profiles required for the Surround Base.
- You have not enabled the Bluetooth function of the device. See the user manual of the device on how to enable the function.
- The device is not correctly connected. Connect the device correctly.
- The Surround Base is already connected with another Bluetooth device. Disconnect the connected device, then try again.

Quality of audio play from a connected Bluetooth device is poor.

- The Bluetooth reception is poor. Move the device closer to the Surround Base, or remove any obstacle between the device and the Surround Base.

The connected Bluetooth device connects and disconnects constantly.

- The Bluetooth reception is poor. Move the device closer to the Surround Base, or remove any obstacle between the device and the Surround Base.
- Turn off Wi-Fi function on the Bluetooth device to avoid interference.
- For some Bluetooth, the Bluetooth connection can be deactivated automatically to save power. This does not indicate any malfunction of the Surround Base.
