

Key Port Presentation




- ①. iPhone Connector: For iPhone external speakers and charging it.
- ②. TV/Earphone port: Earphone output and video output port
- ③. USB-HUB Port: When mainframe connecting to computer, computer can read the data with internal format from USB devices
- ④. Movie Key **MV** : Short press to enter into movie player mode
- ⑤. Setting Key **MUSIC** : press short directly into setting page
- ⑥. Power Switch  : press short directly turn the device on or off
- ⑦. Menu Key **MENU**: Short press to enter into menu
- ⑧. Return Key **ESC** : Short press to return to upper menu
- ⑨. Volume down **v-**: short press to turn the volume down slowly; long press to turn the volume down quickly
- ⑩. Previous Song Key : select previous menu or document, song; long press to quick playback
- ⑪. Play Key : short press, confirm/play/pause/exit menu
- ⑫. Next Song Key : select next menu or document, song; long press to quick forward
- ⑬. Volume up **v+** : short press to turn the volume up slowly, long press to turn the volume up quickly

- ⑱. BASS button: rotate this button can turn the bass on or off
- ⑲. TF card slot: Plug in the TF card, then the player can read and play the documents such as audio documents, videos, pictures and TXT documents within the TF card.
- ⑳. LINE IN Port: Player can play the music from Line IN port by connecting CD, DVD, MP3, MP4, MP5, Mbphone, computer, etc., with a 3.5 audio wire
- ㉑. USB Port: This player can read and play the documents such as audio documents, videos, pictures and TXT documents with the USB devices when the USB devices are inserted.

I. USB Storage Function


- 1). Plug the WALI-G TF card into the card slot of mainframe (Key Port ⑯)
- 2). Plug in the specialized AC adapter and connect to a AC power source.
- 3). Connect this player to a PC using the USB cable; plug the double USB plug side into the USN port on PC, mini plug side into the MINI USB port of this player (key port ⑰)
- 4). Turn the power switch on, which is on the back of the mainframe, waiting for the boot animation to enter into USB storage and HUB function page, as illustrated in the figure below:



- 5). These figures will show up at the bottom of the screen:



Now, launch "My Computer",  and two additional disks will show up, then they could be written and read.




Caution:

If the TF card is inserted after connecting this player with a PC, this player will automatically recognize and load the audio documents in the TF card and transfer to the music player page. No audio output if the AC adapter is not connected. The player will not transfer to music player page if there is no audio document in the TF card.

II.HUB Function

- 1). Plug in the specialized AC adapter and connect to a AC power source.
- 2). Connect this player with a PC by a specialized USB cable
- 3). Turn the power switch on, which is on the back of the mainframe, waiting for the boot animation to enter into USB storage and HUB function page, as illustrated in the figure below:
- 4). Plug in any USB device into the USB-HUB port ③, ⑯, ⑰
- 5). Click the bottom of PC screen as follow:



The player will transfer to UI page after unplugging the USB storage, at this time, music are played, HUB function can still be used when browsing pictures or videos.

Movie Player Function and Basic Operation

Two music player mode are available for this player

1. Short press the **M/V** key to enter the Video playing mode directly
1. Select “**Video**” in the home page by pressing **◀▶**, then press **▶▶** key to enter the menu list. Short press **◀▶▶▶** or **▲/▼** to select “Now Playing” or “Dir list”, then press **▶▶** to confirm.

Now Playing: Continue to play from the previous point. It does not show if it was not played.

Dir List: Internal storage, card catalog. music, which is storage in the card are showed in the

Card Catalog. It shows nothing if there is no card inside.



Key Function and Basic Operations

- 1). **Play/Pause:** press **▶||** to start playing, press again to pause. Press any key to show up and down information and progress bar while playing to execute the relevant order.
- 2). **Fast Forward & Playback:** Long Press **◀◀/▶▶** Key could play fast forward or playback while playing or pausing.
- 3). **Documents switch:** Short Press **◀◀/▶▶** Key could switch up or down documents while playing or pausing.


Short press **◀◀/▶▶** or **▲/▼** select up & down options, press **ESC** to return to the upper menu or exit, same manipulations for all menus.

- 1). **Playback Mode:** Press **▶||** key to enter the options: ordering play, single cycle, all cycle, random and random + repeat.
- 2). **Scan Speed:** press **◀◀/▶▶** Key to adjust the range 0-8.
- 3). **Screen Size :** Full screen, original size, actual size, etc.
- 4). **Resume:** Continuous playing function, turn on or off.
- 5). **Delete :** Delete the current documents.


Key Function Operation



- 3). Select: Select single document, the small icon in front of the folder will show the red **✓** after selecting; press **▶||** key to select or cancel single document
- 4). Move & Copy: Select the document/folder that need to move/copy, long press **MENU** key, select move/copy, then select the destination folder. At that time, long press **MENU** key to pop-up window, showing confirm to move/copy? **Make sure to move?** Select **Yes** to finish.

2). Press **◀/▶** key to move left and right under thumbnail browsing mode.

iPhone Player Function & Basic Operation

Two iPhone player mode are available for this player:

1. Plug iPhone in the iPhone port on top of the mainframe, the player will transfer to iPhone mode at this time.
2. Select  in the home page, press **►||** key to enter the iPhone connection






