




Get started

Keys and parts

1. Charger connector
2. Indicator light
3. Multifunction key
4. Voice control button
5. Earpiece
6. Microphone

Charger the battery



1. Connect SBH-102 and computer or AC adapter with micro-usb cable like the way show in above picture.
2. When charging, the indicator light turns to red.
3. Indicator light turns to blue after fully charged.
4. Pull out the cable after fully charged.

Introduction

About your headset

With the SCUD Bluetooth Mono headset SBT-102, you can handle calls hands-free, even when using two phones at the same time. Read this user guide carefully before using the product. Also, read the user guide for the device that you connect to the product.

About Bluetooth connectivity

You can use Bluetooth to make a wireless connection to other compatible devices, such as mobile phones. Devices don't need to be in direct line-of-sight, but they must be within 10 metres of each other. The connection may be affected by obstructions such as walls or other electronic devices.

This device is compliant with Bluetooth specification 3.0 +EDR supporting the following profiles: headset profile (1.1), handsfree profile(1.5). Check with the manufacturers of other devices to determine their compatibility with this device.

Make calls

Make and receive calls

To make and receive calls using your headset, you need to connect it to your phone.
Make a call - Enter the phone number on your phone and press call control button, the call automatically transfers to the Bluetooth headset.

Answer a call - Press multifunction key to answer a call.
End a call - Press multifunction key to end a call.

Decline a call - Press multifunction key twice.

Switch a call between your headset and phone - Press and hold multifunction key for 2 seconds.

Redial the last call number - Press multifunction key twice.

Handle calls from two phones

Continue an ongoing call, and decline a call on another phone - press multifunction key twice.

End an ongoing call, and answer a call on another phone - press multifunction key.

Put an ongoing call on hold, and answer a call on another phone - press and hold multifunction key for 2 seconds.

Switch between active and held calls - press and hold multifunction key for 2 seconds.

End an ongoing call, and go back to a held call - press multifunction key.

Change the volume

Set the volume by press the voice control button.

Product and safety information Driving safety



Check the battery charge

When the headset is switched on and you've not in a call, press multifunction key. A blue light means there is enough power. If the light is red, recharge the battery.

Switch the headset on or off

Switch on - press and hold multifunction key for 2 seconds, a blue indicator light flashes quickly.

Switch off - Press and hold multifunction key for 3 seconds to switch the headset off, a red indicator light flashes quickly.

Pair the device

Pair and connect the headset to your phone

Before using the headset, you must pair and connect it to a compatible phone. You can pair your headset with 8 phones, but you can only connect it to a maximum of 2 phones at the same time. With some phones, you may need to make the connection separately after pairing. When the headset is connected to a phone, the Bluetooth indicator light flashes slowly.

Pair the headset manually

1. Make sure your headset is switched off and your compatible phone is on.
2. If you've never paired the headset with a device, or you've cleared the pairings, switch the headset on. If you've previously paired your headset with another device, press and hold multifunction key for 5 seconds. Pairing mode is switched on, and a blue and red indicator lights starts to flash quickly.
3. Within 3 minutes, switch Bluetooth on in your phone, then set it to search for Bluetooth devices. For details, see the user guide of the phone.
4. On your phone, select the headset from the list of found devices.

In some devices, you may need to make the connection separately after pairing.

Pair and connect the headset to two devices

1. Make sure Bluetooth is switched on in both phone.
2. To switch the headset off, press and hold multifunction key for 5 seconds.
3. Press and hold multifunction key for 5 seconds to switch pairing mode on, then pair the headset with the second phone.
4. Switch the headset off and back on. The headset connects to both phones.

following measures:

- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.
