PAIRING WITH A BLUETOOTH DEVICE

Make sure the mobile device (Mobile phone, tablet, computer, etc.) you are trying to pair the Bluetooth Speaker with supports Bluetooth. Specific pairing procedures may vary depending on the mobile device you are trying to pair with, for detailed information on using the Bluetooth function of your mobile device, please refer to the mobile devices user guide.

1. Power on the Bluetooth Speaker, Slide the "On/Off Switch" to the ON position, the speaker will speak "The Bluetooth device is ready to pair" The Bluetooth Speaker is now in pairing mode
2. On your mobile device, navigate to Settings>Bluetooth and search/scan for "Tech2 Rainbow" (some mobile devices will begin to search automatically) and select it.
3. Sometimes your mobile device may confirm you want to connect to "Tech2 Rainbow" select "yes" or "enter" to complete the pairing process.

Depending on the mobile device you are trying to connect the speaker to, it may be necessary to enter a passcode. If so, enter "0000".

The Bluetooth Speaker will automatically reconnect to your mobile device when they are powered on and in Bluetooth range

CONNECTING WITH OTHER BLUETOOTH DEVICES

The Bluetooth Speaker can only be connected to one Bluetooth device at a time. To pair the Speaker to a different device (other than the device originally paired with) you must first close the initial Bluetooth connection on the first device, either by shutting off the Bluetooth function, or if the device is out of range, it will be automatically disconnected. Then proceed to pair with the desired device using the previous steps for "Pairing with a Bluetooth Device".

PLAYING MUSIC

When the unit is connected and paired to your device.

- Press the "Play/Pause" (M) button to start playing music or navigate to the music app on your mobile device and select a media file to begin playing.

- Quick press the "Next" or "Previous" buttons to skip to the next or previous track.

- Press and hold the "Next" or "Previous" buttons for volume control.

- Press the "Light" button on the speaker to alternate between different light modes.

You can also control the volume using the volume controls on your mobile device. For maximum volume output make the sure the volume on your mobile device is set to the loudest setting.

CHARGING

-Attach the included Micro USB cable (Smaller end) into the Micro USB charging port of the Bluetooth Speaker, and plug the other end of the cable into a USB charger or USB port on your PC. If the battery is completely dead it will take up to 1.5 hours to fully charge the device.

-The charging indicator light will illuminate red when the unit is charging.
