

■ Introduction

Thank you for buying Bluetooth stereo earphone, it is equipment that can make a call and listen to music, which also can pair two mobiles simultaneously to let listen to music and manage calls do not interfere each other.

The earphone is equipped with built-in rechargeable polymer lithium battery. Please read user manual carefully before use.

■ Overview



1. Volume 2. Function Buttons 3. Charging Port
4. Indicator Lamp 5. Microphone

■ Function Buttons

- Boot: hold for 3 seconds
- Pairing Status: hold for 5 seconds
- Answer calls: press 1 second
- Hang Up: press 1 second
- Redial last call: fast press 2 seconds
- Rejecting Calls: hold for 1 second
- Play/Pause: single-click
- Shutdown: hold for 3 seconds

■ Indicator Lamp

- Boot: blue lights flashed three times quickly
- Pairing Status: red and blue lights flashing Alternately
- Has Been Answered: the blue lights flash twice every five seconds
- Listen to Music: the blue lights flash twice Every two seconds
- Calling: the blue lights flash once Every two seconds
- Low battery red light Flashing
- Charging: steady red light
- Charging completed: blue Lights
- Shutdown: the red light flashes 3 times

■ Pairing

In the off state, long press (5 seconds) function button until the indicator flashing between red and blue alternately and let it go, and then the headset is in pairing searchable situation.

Pairing for iPhone

Settings - Bluetooth - turn on Bluetooth, one device named "Bluetooth" will be searched. Press it and they will pair with each other automatically, no password needed, if be prompted for a password, please enter "0000."

Pairing for Android phone

Settings (Settings) - Wireless and network - Bluetooth settings - Turn on Bluetooth - scan for Bluetooth devices, one device named "Bluetooth" will be found, Press it and they will pair with each other automatically, no password needed, if be prompted for a password, please enter "0000."

For Windows system, according to the user manual of Bluetooth adapter equipped with your own computer to operate it.

■ One for two

Step 1: Paired with the first mobile phone (refer to the pairing)

Step 2: Paired with a second phone (see pairing)

Headset has been disconnected with the first mobile phone when paired with the second phone. At this time, please go to Bluetooth menu of the first cell phone, find the headphone connection (no need to pair again) and connect to it, pairing with two phones has been completed when it is connected.

Note:

Not all cell phone ringtones will sync to the phone, but there is reminder sound when there is call, which will vary from phones.

■ Reconnect

Boot the headset and it will automatically connect to the last paired Bluetooth device (mobile phone). If the headset does not connect automatically, please go to Bluetooth headset menu of Bluetooth device (mobile phone) to find the point of headphone connection. The headset is not connected to any device when in standby condition. It will automatically connect to the last paired Bluetooth device (mobile phone) if pressing function key. Any operation should be within the effective range of the Bluetooth.

■ Charging and Battery

When the headset indicator light flashes in red (Battery Low), it means that the headset is in low battery and please charge the headset.

1. Indicator is red color when the bluetooth charging, when charging is completed it will become blue.
2. Please plug one end of the USB charging cable into the charging port of headphone and the other end of the USB into the USB interface of power adapter (phone charger or other power adapter with USB interface) or USB port of desktop.
3. The charging time is about three hours, charging time varies from output current of power supply unit.

Note:

- (1) When the headset is in low battery, please charge it. Otherwise too low voltage may cause the headset will not charge or does not work properly.
- (2) Please turn off the power when not use.
Please do not store it without any battery.
Please store it in a ventilated dry place.
Please fully charge the headset if stored more than three months.
Please charge it fully before use if it is stored for a long time.

■ Troubleshooting

1. Could not connect: Make sure the headset is turned on, the headset and the phone are within range, the headset is charged, the Bluetooth of phone is turned on, did not change the Bluetooth settings on the phone.
2. Can not be charged: Make sure the power supply is properly connected to headset and charger is inserted into the power outlet, USB cable is connected USB powered device (make sure there is electricity).
