

**Bluetooth pairing:**  
This Model supports HFP, HSP, A2DP, AVRCP

1. Keep the distance between user's device (i.e. cell phone) and the product within 10 meter, and then turn on the power of the product, the blue / red light will keep flashing.
2. Enable Bluetooth function of cell phone and search the Bluetooth devices nearby.
3. Choose "CM5170A" from the device list.
4. The blue light will keep flashing quickly during pairing and light will be off once pairing has been done.
