### **SIM Card**

inWatch Z supports a micro SIM card.

Micro SIM card lets you save data for communication, such as your personal information: PIN code, contacts, messages, etc.

#### **INSERT A SIM CARD**

1. Turn off your inWatch Z.
2. Locate a very small SIM card hole at the left side of the watch (the opposite side of the power button).
3. Push the SIM-eject tool into the small hole until it pops out.
4. Pull the SIM card tray out gently.
5. Place your Micro SIM card in the tray with the golden circuit side facing down.
6. Push the SIM card tray gently back into the slot until you hear it "click" into place.
7. Now turn your inWatch Z on. All of the information on the card will now be in your inWatch Z.

Warning:

Please don't twist or scratch the SIM card, and keep it away from static electricity, dust and water.

Please keep the SIM card and tray away from the children.

## **Bone Conduction Speaker**

## Battery of inWatch Z

inWatch Z features a built-in 580 mAh battery, the performance of which could be influenced by many factors such as network configuration, signal strength, temperature, user settings, and mobile phone accessories used besides voice, data or other application modes.

In order to achieve the best battery performance, please follow the following guidelines:

- It takes a longer time to charge a new battery or one that has been unused for a prolonged period of time.
- When charging, keep the battery at or near ambient temperature.
- As with all rechargeable batteries, after long-term use it will take a longer period of time to charge due to gradual capacity loss. Please note that this is a normal phenomenon.
- If battery is unused for some time, or when battery power is low, a certain interval of time is needed before the normal charging display screen appears.

If the watch is off while charging, the screen will display an status as below.

inWatch Z supports the sending of MMS content. Touch the “+” at the lower-left corner of the screen to add an attachment.

### CONTACTS

Tap the “People” icon at the App Center.

Contacts are arranged in alphabetical order, and only names are displayed on the first page of the phone book.

You can type the name of the contact you want to access in the input box at the top of the screen to search.

There are several locations to save contacts' information, including: inWatch memory, micro SIM card and to a smart phone set up for synchronization with your in-Watch.

Contacts' information include : name, company name, three phone numbers(mobile number, home number, work number), e-mail, fax number, chat icon,etc.

After dialing a number on the calling screen, you can touch the lower-right corner to access the "Contacts" page. Then tapping the "create a new contact" button on the bottom, you can add the number to the phone book.

### **CALENDAR**

Tap the "Calendar" icon at the App Center to access the electronic calendar.

inWatch Z's built-in calendar can display the solar calendar, Chinese lunar date and solar term.You can choose to display by month, week, or day.

To create an event, select the date and time you need. Enter the event information, such as event name, location, time etc.

### **E-MAIL**

To setup your email account when you use it for the first time.select the email setup assistant.Input your password to complete account configuration. You can then

write and receive emails.

inWatch Z can store pictures taken with the built-in camera to the photo album.

Tap the “Album” icon at the App Center to access the album, where your photos will be arranged and displayed.

You can also create individual albums to manage your photos more efficiently.

Touch the cover of the album to open the album. inWatch Z will display the album’s photos in a grid. Touch each picture to view in full-screen mode. To check the next or previous picture, drag to the left or right.

### MUSIC PLAYER

inWatch Z's built-in a music player supports the use of a Bluetooth headset. Supported formats include: MP3, WMA, WAV, 3GP, MP4 and WMV.

Touch the "Music" icon at the App Center to enter the music player.

The Player page shows the information for the song that is currently playing. You can pause or continue playback by tapping the middle of the screen.

Tap the upper-left corner to access the playlist.

You can play a song by tapping its title on the playlist page.

Tap the upper-right corner to toggle shuffle mode on or off.

Tap middle-left to replay the currently playing song. Tap it twice to go to the previous song.

Tap middle-right to skip to the next song.

By sliding your finger across the playback progress bar you can adjust the playback volume.

inWatch Z features a built-in video player . The playback formats supported include: AVI, RM, RMVB and ASF.

Tap the “Video” icon at the App Center to enter the video folder. Video preview screens are displayed in a grid. You can tap any preview to play the video.

After accessing the playback screen, the current video’s name will be displayed at the top of the screen, you can tap the button next to the name to share the video.

By tapping the middle of the screen, you can pause or resume video playback.

The bar at the bottom of the video displays playback progress.

Tap the lower-right corner to enter full-screen mode.

## Mobile App of inWatch Z

### INCLUB

#### 1) Download inClub

You can download inClub from the inWatch's official website, or search it from the App Market.

#### 2) inClub function

inClub is an application to connect your inWatch Z to inWatch's cloud services. Input your inClub ID to login.

iCloud provides private cloud storage, quick setting the smart watch, remind you the incoming call and message from the cell phone. inClub is still under development and more features will be added in future updates.

#### 3) inClub operation instruction

a. Download and launch the inClub app on your smartphone. Make sure that Bluetooth is enabled on both your smartphone and inWatch Z, and that they are within connection range of each other. Pair them from within the inClub app.

b. Use your Baidu ID to register and log in (Your Baidu ID will serve as your in-Watch ID)

c. Tap the upper-right corner to find "account management" and set up your account information. This includes your avatar, nickname, WeChat QR code, etc.

d. Touch the upper-right corner to find "watch setup". You can quickly set up incoming call reminders, message reminders, and set the device's time here.

e. Touch the upper-right corner to find "Check for updates" to check if any software updates are available for the inWatch Z.
