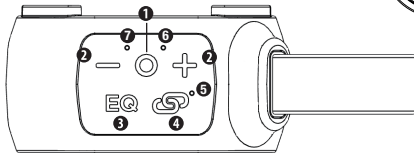
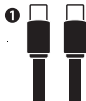

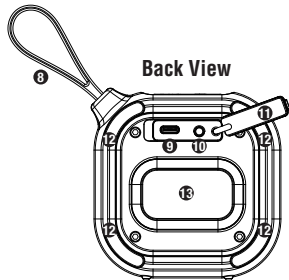

DEFINITIONS: SAFETY GUIDELINES

GETTING STARTED

CHARGE THE SPEAKER

Connect one Type C end of the charging cable into the speaker and the other Type C end into a power source. **Make sure the speaker is fully charged before using it for the first time.**

⚠ WARNING: Use only with a Listed Class 2 USB power adapter that is compliant with applicable country regulations and international/regional safety standards. Using adapters that do not meet applicable safety standards could result in injury.

⚠ WARNING: Observe the safety instructions of the charger being used to power this device.

PAIR THE SPEAKER WITH YOUR BLUETOOTH DEVICE

- Press and hold the speaker's ON/OFF button **(1)** to turn the speaker on. If not previously paired, the speaker will automatically enter pairing mode.
- Turn on the Bluetooth function of your Bluetooth device and pair the speaker with your Bluetooth device.

THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS SHOW YOU HOW TO FIND THE SPEAKER ON BLUETOOTH DEVICE

Turn on the Bluetooth function of your Bluetooth device and select "**BLACK+DECKER WIRELESS SPEAKER**".

PAIR THE SPEAKER WITH ANOTHER BLUETOOTH DEVICE

If you have another Bluetooth device that you want to pair with the speaker, make sure the Bluetooth function in any other previously paired or connected devices is turned off. Then follow the steps in "PAIR THE SPEAKER WITH YOUR BLUETOOTH DEVICE."

CONTROLS

To turn speaker ON:

Press and hold the ON/OFF button

To turn speaker OFF:

Press and hold the ON/OFF button

RECONNECTING TO A DISCONNECTED DEVICE

- If previously connected to a Bluetooth device, the speaker will automatically reconnect with that device when powered on.
- If the Bluetooth device is outside the speaker's distance range, the speaker will not automatically reconnect.

AUX IN

- Insert audio cable to AUX IN **(10)** to change to AUX mode.
- Press Volume Controls **(2)** to increase or decrease the volume.
- Press the ON/OFF button **(1)** to mute.

LINK TO ANOTHER BLACK+DECKER MAGNETIC WIRELESS SPEAKER

1. Press the LINK button **(4)** on the PRIMARY SPEAKER. The LINK LED indicator **(5)** will light up in white.
2. Power on the SECONDARY SPEAKER(s) and press the LINK button **(4)**. The LINK LED indicator **(5)** will flash green while searching for the PRIMARY SPEAKER. Once linked, the indicator will turn solid green.
 - Primary Speaker: Controls volume, play, pause, and previous/next for all connected devices.



Secondary Speaker(s): Can only adjust its own volume or power off.

Primary speaker can connect to 100+ secondary speakers.

DISCONNECT LINKING

- To disconnect LINKING, press the LINK button **(4)** on either the Primary or Secondary Speaker. The LINK LED indicator **(5)** will turn off.

NOTE:

- If you long press the LINK button on a Secondary Speaker, it will exit LINKING mode and enter Bluetooth searching status.
- The Primary Speaker will remain in its previous connection status.

MANAGE YOUR MUSIC:

Play or Pause music: Press the ON/OFF button **(1)** once

- **Forward (next song):** Press and hold "+" button for 2 seconds
- **Volume increase:** Press "+" button
- **Backward (previous song):** Press and hold "-" button for 2 seconds
- **Volume decrease:** Press "-" button

CALL CONTROLS

USE THE ON/OFF BUTTON

- **Answer/Hang up:** Press the ON/OFF button **(1)**
- **Reject incoming call:** Press and hold the ON/OFF button **(1)** for 2 seconds
- **Voice Control - Siri/Google:** Double-click the ON/OFF button **(1)**

Reset

FACTORY RESET

- Long press the “-” and “+” buttons simultaneously
for **6 seconds**.
