# **Tech Specifications:**

## Lamp&Speaker:

Pairing name: Shine Speaker

Bluetooth version: 5.4

Lamp&Speaker Charging time: about 2.5 hours.

Playing time in max volume of Speaker: about 5 hours with lamp off.

## Wireless Charger:

Wireless charger input: 5V 3A; 9V 2.22A,

Wireless charger output: 5W/7.5W/10W/15W.

USB A&C outputs: Total 5V/1A Max.

### How to use lamp and speaker:

(Be sure to fully charge the speaker before using for the first time)

### 1. Charge the speaker lamp

- Plug the Type-C connector of the included charging cable into the charging port on the lamp&speaker (6).
  Plug the large connector into a USB power source, such as a DC 5V USB wall adapter (not included).
- The charging LED indicator (4) will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when fully charged.

#### 1. Use lamp:

The Re-chargeable lamp has 3 main lighting modes: Cool White Light & Warm Light & Natural Light.

Turn on on the light switch. (slid the button to the "🎝" mark position)

Short touch the top of the lamp to turn on the light.

Short touch the top of the lamp again to switch between 3 light modes.

Touch and hold the top of the lamp to adjust the brightness.

WARNING: AVOID EYE CONTACT WITH THE LIGHT. THE LIGHT SOURCE OF THIS LUMINAIRE IS NOT REPLACEABLE; WHEN THE LIGHT SOURCE REACHES ITS END OF LIFE THE WHOLE LUMINAIRE SHALL BE REPLACED.

#### 2.Bluetooth Setup:

Slid the power button (3) to the "BT" mark position to turn on the speaker ,working LED indicator (4) will flash BLUE when in pairing mode.

- Turn on the Bluetooth function on mobile device, Select" Shine Speaker" pairing name.
- LED will turn solid BLUE if successfully paired, the LED will flash in BLUE slowly when playing.
- Speaker will automatically pair if the mobile device has been paired before.
- Slid the button to the front positions to power off the speaker.
- If disconnect Bluetooth after 5 mins, the speaker Bluetooth will auto shut off.

Please adjust the speaker volume and adjust the tracks by your Phone directly.

There is a microphone in the speaker, you can pick up the call from your Phone when there is a call.

### How to use wireless charger:

 Connect the provided Type-C USB to USB-A cable to the Type-C USB input port (8), then connect the USB end of the cable to a USB power adapter..

USB adapter must also support 5V 3A; 9V 2.22A.

To achieve better performance, quick-charge power adapter is recommended. (15W at least, not included).

- Place the wireless charging supported mobile phone on the wireless charging surface (2), please align the position, the led (9) LED will glow RRD when Phone is charging.
- Once fully charged remove the device.

**Note:** When wireless charging, if the Led indicator flash BLUE the device is either NOT a wireless charging device or there is an object between the the device and charging surface interfering with the charging process.

Charging mobile phones and other electronic devices by the wireless charge base USB outputs: Note: The wireless charge base without battery, before use the side USB A&C USB outputs(7) to charge external devices, you need to plug in the input(8) USB cable

- Insert Type-C connector of the USB cable to the charging port (8) and the other USB A connector to a adapter, make sure there is power input.
- Connect another charging cable to your mobile phone/device using the appropriate connector.
- Connect the USB part of the cable into either USB outputs (7) ports.
- Remove the cable from your mobile device when it is fully charged.
