

# Quick guide

The contents of this manual may different in certain respects from the description of your phone depending on its software version and your telephone operator.

## English

## How to use the phone keys

In any screen, Tap ( "< ", "< ", "< ", "=" ), to return to previous screen or exit the application.

Tap("o", "o", "o") Home Key, to return to the main menu. Tap("...","...."," o"," ∈ "), to display the settings/option list. Tap the "on/off" button, to turn on or off the screen and block the screen.

Long press " on/off " to shut down or to restart your mobile.

Press and hold the "on/off" button and then press the volume down key to take a screen capture.

## Language

Tap the settings icon. Scroll down and tap the "Language and input", then choose language in the field "language".

## Calls

Press the "contact" icon, email, message or any number on the phone to make a phone call. Or make a phone call by inputting the number on the dial keyboard on the "dial" application.

## Message

Tap the "Messaging" icon to send messages to your contacts. Input a name or a number on the receiver field or choose someone from your contact list, then press the send button after writing your message.

Press the " 

" button if you want to attach a picture, a video, a file, etc...

## Writing and copying a text

Mobile phone will make recommendation while you write. If you want to copy or cut a text, long press the text for a few seconds and use the selecting arrows to select, or the "select all" options and copy or paste your text.

## Camera

Tap the "camera" icon to open the camera. Mobile phone supports a variety of picture modes, HDR panoramic, automatic smile mode, etc... Voice control allows to take group or family pictures without having to touch the phone.

# Gallery

## Video camera

Tap the "Camera" icon to open the camera and switch to video mode. Tap " 

to record videos.

## Mail

Tap the "Email" icon. After setting your email account, you can send and receive emails in your phone anywhere you are.

## Music

Tap the "Music" icon, and listen to your music. Playlist can be categorized by artists, albums and others.

## **FM Radio**

Connect the earphones to the audio jack, tap the "Radio" icon and select frequency.

## Theme

Tap ("...","...."," = ") and in the main screen, select "Wallpaper", select a picture and then tap "Set as wallpaper".

# Guía rápida

#### **Botones exteriores**

En cualquier pantalla:

Pulsa ("<", "<", "=") para volver a la pantalla anterior o salir.

Pulsa ( 'o', 'o', 'a') tecla de inicio para volver a la pantalla de inicio.

Pulsa("...","...."," ⇒ "," ≡ ")para acceder a las opciones de configuración. Pulse "on/off" para bloquear o desbloquear la pantalla.

Mantenga pulsado "on/off" para apagar o reiniciar el teléfono.

Pulse "on/off" y el boton de bajar el volumen para realizar una captura de pantalla.

#### Idiomas

Pulse el icono de "Ajustes" y entre en la opcion de "idioma y entrada de texto" Para cambiar de idioma.

#### **Hacer Hamadas**

Pulse el icono de contactos, email, mensajes o cualquier numero de teléfono en el móvil para realizar una llamada. También puede hacer llamadas usando el teclado en la aplicación "Teléfono".

## Mensaje

Pulse el icono de mensajes para enviar un mensaje a un contacto. Escriba un numero de teléfono o un nombre en el campo "recipiente" o escoja un contacto de la lista de contactos, a continuación escriba el mensaje que desea enviar y pulse el botón de enviar. Pulse " 

" si quiere añadir , fotos, videos, etc...

## Escritura y copia

Teléfono móvil hace recomendaciones al escribir. Si quiere copiar un texto, púlselo durante unos segundo y a continuación podrá copiarlo o cortarlo.

#### Grabación

Pulse el icono de "cámara" para tomar una foto. El Teléfono móvil incluye una variedad de modos inteligentes, HDR panorámico, modo sonrisa. El control por voz permite realizar fotos en grupo y familiar sin tocar el teléfono.

## Galería de fotos y edición

### Vídeo

Pulse el icono de "cámara" para iniciar la cámara, cambie a modo grabación. Pulse " 

para grabar vídeos.

#### **Enviar Email**

Pulse el icono de "email" y después de configurar su cuenta podrá recibir y enviar correos electrónicos desde su móvil.

## Musica

Pulse el icono de "Musica" y disfrute de su musica ordenada por artistas álbumes y otras categorías.

## Radio FM

Inserte los auriculares en el conector. Pulse el icono de "Radio" para escuchar la radio.

## Cambiar de fondo de pantalla

Pulse ("--"." -- "." = ") y elija una imagen para establecerla como fondo de pantalla.
