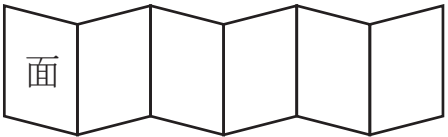





Power On/Off




Front

Back


- Press & hold the ON/OFF button 2 second to turn on the Remote Control Inflatable Stitch.
- Press & hold the ON/OFF button 2 second to turn off the Remote Control Inflatable Stitch.

Base Extension



- Press the button to unlock and extend the base for better stability.

Remote Control Stitch Battery Charging




- Make sure switch off the Remote Control Inflatable Stitch before charging.
- Unscrew the screw on the battery box cover to open the cover.
- Unplug and take out the rechargeable li-ion battery.
- Connect the Rechargeable Li-ion Battery to the charging cable and plug on a USB power adapter for charging.
- The LED indicator on the charging cable will turn red while charging and will turn green once fully charged.

⚠ For your safety, please always use appropriate 5V output charger/Adapter to charge the product.
DO NOT USE Quick Charging USB Adapter to charge the product, as it might damage the product.


- You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer.

Battery Installation For Remote Control Stitch



- To install battery into the Remote Control Inflatable Stitch, unscrew the screw on the battery box cover to open the cover.
- Connect the rechargeable li-ion battery to the Remote Control Inflatable Stitch.
- Insert the rechargeable li-ion battery into the battery box.
- Replace the battery box cover and tighten the screw.

Batteries Installation For Remote Control



- To install batteries into the Remote Control, unscrew the screw on the battery box cover to open the cover.
- Insert 2 x "AA" 1.5V batteries (Not Included) into the battery box.
- Batteries should be placed as shown on the diagram.
- Replace the battery box cover and tighten the screw.

Notice:

When inserting the batteries, you must insert according to the correct polarity, the Remote Control won't function if batteries are reversed.

⚠ Li-ion battery charging warning statement

The input to the product is 5V 2A.
In order to charge the product in safe manner and reliable conditions, please only adopt certified appropriate charger/ adapter for charging the product. Only charge the product at ambient temperatures between 10 °C/ 50 °F and 40 °C/104 °F. Do not heat above 70 °C/158 °F, eg. Do not expose to sunlight or throw into fire. Please note that we won't take any responsibility for any wrong operation (eg. Voltage higher than 5V) as this may result in severe injury or loss of property, and we cannot control the operating process during the time the user using this product.

For AA Batteries

Performance Tips

1. Do not drive the Remote Control Inflatable Stitch on grass, sand or go through water.
2. Do not drive the Remote Control Inflatable Stitch in windy or rainy weather.
3. Do not drive the Remote Control Inflatable Stitch into any sharp object.
4. Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from Remote Control Inflatable Stitch.

Care and Maintenance

Always use dry and soft cloth to clean this product.

Avoid this product from being exposed to sunlight or heat.

Avoid immersing these toys in water, otherwise, the electronic parts may be damaged.

Check the product regularly. If any damages are discovered, please stop using immediately, until it is completely repaired in good working condition.

Warning

This product is suitable for individuals with operating experience in remote toys or those aged 8 years old and above.

Please do not put the product in your mouth to prevent choking hazards from small parts.

Avoid inserting your fingers into available interspaces.
