



Only use the included USB Type-C power cable to operate this product.</div></div></div></div></div>	<div><div>Installation</div><div><div><div><div><div>Top Cover</div><div>Water Resist Plug</div></div><div></div><div>Water Tank</div></div></div><div><div>1. Remove the Top Cover and Water Resist Plug 2. Fill up the water tank with distilled water to 80% full. (It is recommended to use distilled or filtered water, instead of tap water.) (mixed with 2% dish soap will increase the smoothness of the snow effect) 3. Install the Water Resist Plug and Top Cover, dry the surface of the speaker. 4. Run the speaker for 3-5 minutes to release the air bubbles from the water pump. (refer to "Power On/Off" section) 5. Remove the USB Power Cable and pour the Decoration Beads to the Water Tank. 6. Fill up the water tank if needed. 7. Install the Water Resist Plug and Top Cover, dry the surface of the speaker. 8. Change water occasionally when dirty.</div><div>Note: Do not immerse the speaker in water. Completely dry the speaker's surface before plug-in the USB Power Cable. Do not operate the speaker when there is any water leakage. When the product was accidentally fell down, immediately remove the power source in safe condition and pick up the product.</div></div></div></div>	<div><div>Power On/Off</div><div><div>Power on Connect the Snow Water Speaker to a 5V/1A USB Adapter (not included) with supplied USB Type-C Power Cable. Long press ON/OFF switch for 3 second for "ON".</div><div>Power off Long press 3 second for "OFF".</div><div>Note: If the Bluetooth function is in sleep mode, the Power off will not function.</div></div><div><div>Bluetooth Speaker Mode</div><div>Play/Pause: Short press the ON/OFF Button once. Next Track: Short press the ">" Button Previous Track: Short press the "<" Button Volume Up: Long press the ">" Button Volume Down: Long press the "<" Button</div><div>Note: The Bluetooth function will goto sleep mode when it was not connect for 5 minutes. Short press the ON/OFF button once will wake-up the Bluetooth function.</div></div><div><div>FM Radio Mode</div><div>Switch to FM Radio Mode: Short press the "M" Button once. Short press the "M" Button again will back to Bluetooth Speaker mode. Auto Scan: Long press the "M" Button. Next Channel: Short press the ">" Button Previous Channel: Short press the "<" Button Volume Up: Long press the ">" Button Volume Down: Long press the "<" Button Mute/Unmute: Short press the ON/OFF Button</div></div><div><div>Pair Bluetooth Speaker With Your Mobile Device</div><div><div>1. Keep the distance between your Bluetooth speaker and mobile phone (or other Bluetooth devices) within 32 Feet. 2. Power on the Bluetooth speaker. 3. Activate the Bluetooth function on your phone within range and select " SP-0771 SPK " from the list shown. 4. You will hear a beep sound when pairing is successful.</div></div><div><div>Reconnect Bluetooth Speaker to Your Mobile Device</div><div>When powered on, the Bluetooth speaker will automatically connect with the last successfully paired device.</div></div></div></div>
<div><div>Snow Moving Effect</div><div>Double Press the ON/OFF Button to start or stop the Snow Moving Effect.</div></div>	<div><div>FAQ</div><div><div><div>◆ If the Bluetooth speaker cannot be paired with your device, please try the following:</div><div>Ensure that your speaker is in pairing mode or reconnection mode.
